I have registered but am unable to speak tonight. Please let me bring to your attention concerns at

Burrows Park, 26 Burrows Rd. Madison. I have authorized Laura Vogel to read my comments. As background information I have lived at 17 Harbort Drive, which borders the South side of Burrows Park, for over 30 years.

Throughout those 30 years I have witnessed many graduation parties, weddings, picnics, yoga classes etc. Nothing however topped the afternoon and evening of Sunday September 26th, 2021.

The amplified music which started at about 3:30 p.m. was extremely loud, and totally inappropriate for a residential neighborhood with children; the music went on until approximately 9:00.

With a personal background in stage productions which includes experience working with amplified sound, I know the level of the sound was certainly within the control of the group that rented Burrows Park on 9-26-21.

And yes, I did call the Park Ranger, who seemed unable to do anything about the amplified music due to the current guidelines in place.

I ask that if the Commission permits amplified music then the decibel level needs to be below 75 and the Park Rangers must enforce this guideline.
