PETITION FOR VARIANCE

2221 Mustang Way (C-10-75-2017) Chris Kilen of Kilen Engineering appealing IBC 503.1 and IBC 903.2.4. The rule requires automatic sprinklers because the addition exceeds the area limits. The variance is requested because a fire wall would restrict movement. The proposal is to sprinkle entire building over the next ten years. The Madison Fire Department supports the variance as long as all high-piled and Group A plastics storage is sprinkled. The balance of the building shall be sprinkled by 12-31-2024. Alder District 16

 2. 49168 1705-1721 Autumn Lake Pkwy (C-10-78-2017) Randy Bruce of Knothe & Bruce appealing IBC 706.1.1. The proposal is to build a commercial 9-unit building connected as one, on 9 parcels, each 24 feet wide. The proposal is to construct a one-hour fire barrier between the units. Alder District 17 The Madison Fire Department supports the variance with 2-hour fire barriers and the units sprinkled with a 13D sprinkler system. It was believed that since each unit had an independent system, it would be easier to service the sprinkler over the years. A motion to approve was made by Brown and seconded by Baldwin. The motion carried unanimously.
