ITEMS CONSIDERED

1. 06306 Authorizing the Madison Department of Public Health to accept up to \$525,000 from the Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services Division of Public Health for the Women, Infants, and Children Nutrition Program (WIC) for the period of January 1, 2007 to December 31, 2007 and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to sign for the City of Madison.
