



Pre-event activities will be limited to the 200 block of MLK Blvd. This section of road will be opened up immediately upon start of the event, as no structures will be placed in the road. All post-race activities will be conducted off the street on private property at 701 E Washington Avenue.

Based upon our selected course layout and the time of day the event will be held, we do not expect any additional street closures would be required. However, we do anticipate special duty officer needs at the intersections of King / Wilson Streets and Blair / John Nolen Dr / Wilson / Williamson Streets.

The only structural items used in the road would be two small start / finish trusses that would be removed as soon as possible. For traffic / participant control, we anticipate the use of cones, verticades, and crowd control barriers. Again, all of these items would be removed from the course as soon as possible.

Event Route Description:

- Start: Wilson Street at MLK Blvd
- ** Northeast on Wilson Street toward Blair Street using only the northern-most lane
- Proceed across Blair Street and enter Capital City Bike Trailhead
- Left (north) onto Blount Street to Main Street
- Right (east) onto Main Street to Ingersoll Street
- Right (south) onto Ingersoll to Wilson Street
- Left (east) onto Wilson Street to Dickinson Street
- Left (north) onto Wilson Street to Main Street
- Right (east) onto Main Street to Northern Court
- Right (south) onto Northern Court to Dickinson Street
- Left (south) onto Dickinson Street to Wilson Street
- Right (west) onto Wilson Street
- Continue on Wilson Street / Capital City Bike Trail to Blount Street
- Right (north) onto Blount Street
- Finish: Parking lane on east side of Blount Street prior to entry into High Noon Saloon parking lot.
- *All roads except MLK and Dickinson to remain open in one direction to traffic.*
- **All runners will be through Wilson St. and Blair St. in less than 7 minutes.**
- ***Course will be coned and barricaded as needed per Engineering and PD.***

Safety and Security Plan:

Course:

The course will be monitored by a combination of Speical Duty Officers, course marshals, volunteers and race staff. We will have two-way radios with a repeater to maintain communication. An EMT will be raoming the course. All RDE staff are trained in CPR/AED. We will have an ambulance staffed and staged at the start area.

Post-Race:

High Noon Saloon will be monitoring any liquor sales as part of the event contract. All patrons will be required to show a valid ID. The post-race activities will be cut off at 16:00 SHARP! There will be EMT/Medical on location until 16:00.
