Alderperson Schumacher said that he would like to see no hard liquor sales in gas/convenience stores.

Mr. Hart said the committee should be acting in the least restrictive means to carry out the committee's functions. He said someone needs to tell him how this proposal would reduce crime, and show him a correlation between these sales and domestic violence.

Mr. Shapiro responded that this is about leveling the playing field for Class A license holders.

Mr. Sentmanat said that the committee has committed itself to a comprehensive approach to addressing the ease of alcohol access. He said that a lot of empirical data has been presented to the committee on the general correlation between the ease of alcohol access and crime. This proposal targets cheap and fast highs, and the ease of alcohol access, he said.

Mr. Hart said that the committee needs to look at all cheap highs if they are talking about a comprehensive approach. He said jobs, training, justice, and equal access to health care must be taken care of first.
