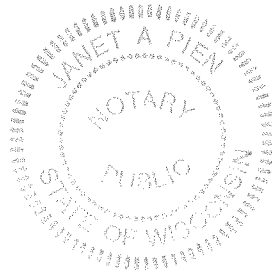

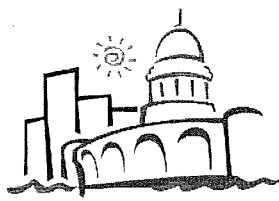

The City of Madison is proposing to resurface N. & S. Rosa Road and to install sidewalk along N. Rosa Road. This project involves special assessments to owners of property on the project. You are being sent this letter to notify you of the public hearing before the Board of Public Works at the above referenced date, time & location. City Engineering will be making a short presentation at the meeting, followed by the public hearing. Attached to this letter is a schedule of assessments that contains the estimated cost for each property on the project.

The proposed improvements include replacing the water mains and laterals; replacing portions of the curb and gutter and drive aprons; installing sidewalk north of Regent Street; and resurfacing the street.

Street Improvements

The proposed street improvements include replacing portions of the concrete curb and gutter and the asphalt pavement. Sidewalk will be installed, along both sides of the street, north of Regent Street in those areas where sidewalk does not currently exist.

The City and the property owners adjoining the reconstruction will share the cost of the street improvements. The City shares the cost on a 50-50 basis with the property owners for removing and replacing sidewalk and curb and gutter. The cost of new sidewalk and concrete drive aprons is the responsibility of the property owner and they will be assessed 100% of the cost. The City is responsible for the remaining street related items. The attached Schedule of Assessments shows a breakdown of costs for each of the assessable items and the total estimated cost to be assessed to each adjacent property owner. Pedestrian Safety Enhancements

Pedestrian safety enhancements are proposed to be included with the project. The enhancements include a pedestrian refuge islands on Rosa Rd, north of South Hill Drive, Belin Street and Gettle Avenue; bumped out curb on the northeast corner of Rosa Rd. and Stadium Dr.; and the installation of a triangular island on Regent Street at Rosa Rd. Storm Sewer

The storm sewer main, leads, and inlets will be replaced as part of this project. The costs to connect existing private connections to curb (often downspouts or sump pumps) are assessable. If you are aware of any existing private connections you have to the storm sewer system (either the curb or a structure) or would like a private connection to be provided as part of this project, please contact the storm sewer engineer. Max Conway is also the storm sewer designer for this project; you may contact him with questions at 261-9127 or mconway@cityofmadison.com.

Impact on Trees and Landscaping

City Forestry will be evaluating trees along the project to determine condition and to determine tree protection specifications. Sewer lateral conflicts with trees will be evaluated by City Forestry and City Engineering. It is anticipated that trees will need to

be removed, from the right-of-way, at the following address: 5702 Anchorage Ave., 200 & 203 Bordner Dr., 5601 Elder Place, and 1, 2, 14 & 40 N. Rosa Rd. to accommodate the sidewalk construction.

Tree pruning in advance of the project is required to reduce the risk of damage to the trees during construction. The City of Madison – Forestry Section will perform the necessary work. For certain species, especially oak and elm trees, the pruning must be completed by mid-April to reduce the chance of disease.

Please note that construction will also have an impact on landscape features in the terrace. With the nature of this work, property owners should anticipate that the terrace area, adjacent to any curb replacement or utility lateral replacement, will be disturbed. Therefore, any plantings or special landscaping features that an owner wishes to save from damage should be removed from the terrace area prior to the start of construction.

Water Main Replacement

Water main will be replaced within the project limits. If you have any questions or concerns with regards to the water main work, please contact Adam Wiederhoeft, of the Madison Water Utility, at 266-9121 or awiederhoeft@madisonwater.org.

Assessments - General

A special assessment is a special charge for work that the City is planning to complete. The attached schedule of assessments shows an estimate of the property owners' share of the project based upon the City's assessment policy. When the project is bid, and work is complete, a final assessment will be calculated based on work actually performed. The final assessment is payable in one lump sum or over a period of 8 years, with 3.0% interest charged on the unpaid balance.

That on WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 18 2012, AT 6:30 P.M., the Board of Public Works will hold a public hearing in ROOM 201 (COMMON COUNCIL CHAMBERS) OF THE CITY COUNTY BUILDING and will consider any objections that may be filed in writing or in person and hear all persons desiring to be heard, and;

That special assessments may be paid over an eight (8) year period, with the owner paying 1/8 of the principal each year plus three (3%) percent interest on the unpaid balance, as determined by the Board of Public Works.

That if the total assessment is paid in full before October 31st in the year that the billing is made, irrespective of project completion, then no interest shall be charged.
