## 2. Parks Division, page 103

Capital assets will be redistributed to the correct services. This will result in an increase in the Botanical Gardens (\$9,000) and Mall Concourse (\$39,800) services, and a corresponding decrease in the Warner Park Community Recreation Center service (\$48,800). There is no impact on the tax levy.

### 3. Golf Enterprise, page 111

Correct highlight #1 to indicate that the eliminated Public Works Maintenance Worker 1 position is currently filled, and that the worker currently filling the position will be transferred to a vacant slot in the Parks Division upon elimination of the position. There is no impact on the tax levy.

### 4. Streets Division, page 117

Expand the Street Cleaning Service description to indicate that this service also includes costs related to the graffiti removal program. There is no impact on the tax levy.

## 5. Fleet Service, page 132

Increase capital assets by \$247,000, and decrease Supplies by \$247,000. The detail shown in the supplement is correct. There is no impact on the tax levy.

## 6. Water Utility, Supplement page 32

Adjust the 2007 column of the Permanent Salary Detail supplement to accommodate the following changes already approved during 2007.

- Delete one FTE Water Construction Inspector (16-14) and add one FTE Civil Technician (16-14). This action was approved via RES-07-00340.
- Delete two FTE Public Works Maintenance Worker 1 (16-08) positions and add two FTE Public Works Maintenance Worker 3 positions (16-11). This action was approved via RES-07-00642
- Delete one FTE Water Meter Mechanic 2 (16-11) and add one FTE Electronics Maintenance Technician (16-17). This action was approved via RES-07-00856
