SUMMARY:

At its meeting of April 19, 2006, the Urban Design Commission **RECEIVED AN INFORMATIONAL PRESENTATION** on a PUD(GDP-SIP), mixed-unit condominium development located at 9401 Mid-Town Road. Appearing on behalf of the project was Casey Louther. The project will provide for the development of 64 condominium units consisting of four 16-unit condominium style buildings, five duplex condominium structures and eleven single-family condominium homes on several platted lots interspersed with extended public right-of-way featuring a shared stormwater management area and community center and pool. The duplex units feature one driveway access per elevation. Although all units feature on-site parking, street parking within the area is provided. All buildings will feature a brick masonry façade. Following the presentation, the Commission noted the following:

- The site has large existing vegetation. Identify the vegetation that can be maintained and preserved within the project limits, especially along lot lines.
- Provide landscaping and screening of surface parking and drive aisle areas of the adjacent public right-of-way, including the detention area.
- Attempt to reduce surface parking adjacent to the courtyard between Buildings No.'s 1 and 4.
- The handling and adjustment of grades architecturally will require further attention with future consideration of the project.
- Examine providing parallel parking instead of diagonal or perpendicular along the private drives of the four building multiple unit site.
- Examine sidewalk continuity to the southerly units on the four 16-unit lot.
- Look at articulation of public versus private open spaces across the combined sites.

ACTION:

Since this was an **INFORMATIONAL PRESENTATION**, no formal action was taken by the Commission.

After the Commission acts on an application, individual Commissioners rate the overall design on a scale of 1 to 10, including any changes required by the Commission. The ratings are for information only. They are not used to decide whether the project should be approved. The scale is 1 = complete failure; 2 = critically bad; 3 = very poor; 4 = poor; 5 = fair; 6 = good; 7 = very good; 8 = excellent; 9 = superior; and 10 = outstanding. The overall ratings for this project are 5, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6, and 6.5.
