

Tree-Trimming Notice

Your safety and electric service reliability are important to us. MGE will be trimming trees near our power lines in your neighborhood in 2013 to minimize tree-related storm damage and electrical outages.

As a National Arbor Day Foundation "Tree Line USA Utility," we are concerned about the health and appearance of trees in your neighborhood. We require our contract crews to carefully trim trees as outlined in the Tree Maintenance Standard distributed by the International Society of Arboriculture.

MGE works with the City Forester and the City of Madison Parks Department to plan tree trimming on the public rights-of-way of streets, alleys, parks and greenways. MGE's 2013 plan for trimming trees on the public rights-of-way will be considered by the Madison Tree Board on March 18, 2013, at 4:30 p.m., at the Goodman Maintenance Facility, 1402 Wingra Creek Pkwy., Room 103. If you have any concerns about MGE tree-trimming plans, you may appear before the Madison Tree Board at that time.

You will receive another notice approximately two weeks prior to actual trimming.
