RESOLUTIONS APPROVING THE CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS

23. 12002

Approving plans and specifications and authorizing the Board of Public Works to advertise and receive bids for Capital City Trail - Acewood Interim Path. (16th AD)

Estimated cost of this project is \$210,000. This project calls for the construction of a 10-foot wide, paved bicycle and pedestrian path through Acewood Park from Leo Drive to Deerwood Drive. This project is a segment of the Capital City Trail and will provide an interim connection of the path between Cottage Grove Road and Buckeye Road until such time as property can be acquired from the railroad to complete the ultimate path. The interim connection makes use of bike lanes on Cottage Grove Road and on-street routes including Vernon Avenue and Leo Drive. It also makes use of existing sidewalk connections between the south end of Acewood Park and Buckeye Road.
