





# 2005 Campus Master Plan, Recreating Ourselves in Place



- Maintain enrollment ~42K
- Suggested growth of 7M GSF via infill, replacement & new buildings
- Decompression of existing & new teaching & research facilities
- Completed 35% of recommendations








