<u>Project Applicants</u> are responsible for the following items:

- Project is built to specifications & locations identified in the project application.
- Project is built to WisDOT standards, or the project applicant must request an exception to WisDOT standards – ideally prior to construction – in writing and be approved by the WisDOT Regional Office.
- By state statute you are required to provide the name of your **current** Treasurer and address for the reimbursement payment.
- The TSMEGP is a reimbursement program. Local governments are required to initially finance 100% of project costs prior to seeking reimbursement. All projects under this program are locally let. While it is expected that many of these projects will be let to contract, it may be possible for the local government to perform the work, provided it has the necessary resources and/ or agreements in place to do so. Once the improvement is completed and the contractor(s) paid (if applicable), the local government can request reimbursement from WisDOT.

Please submit the following documents to the WisDOT Program Manager by (Month, date, year):

- ➤ Bid award and rejection notices, <u>or</u> dated board minutes indicating the bid decision if applicable.
- > Exception to standards, if required.
- > Copies of the project invoices showing payment to the contractor prior to submitting the Request for Reimbursement.
- Local governments that use their own labor force must maintain a record of the labor hours and equipment used time and equipment work orders or logs. These may be requested by the WisDOT Program Manger to verify local cost share upon receipt of the Request for Reimbursement.
- > Request for Reimbursement.
