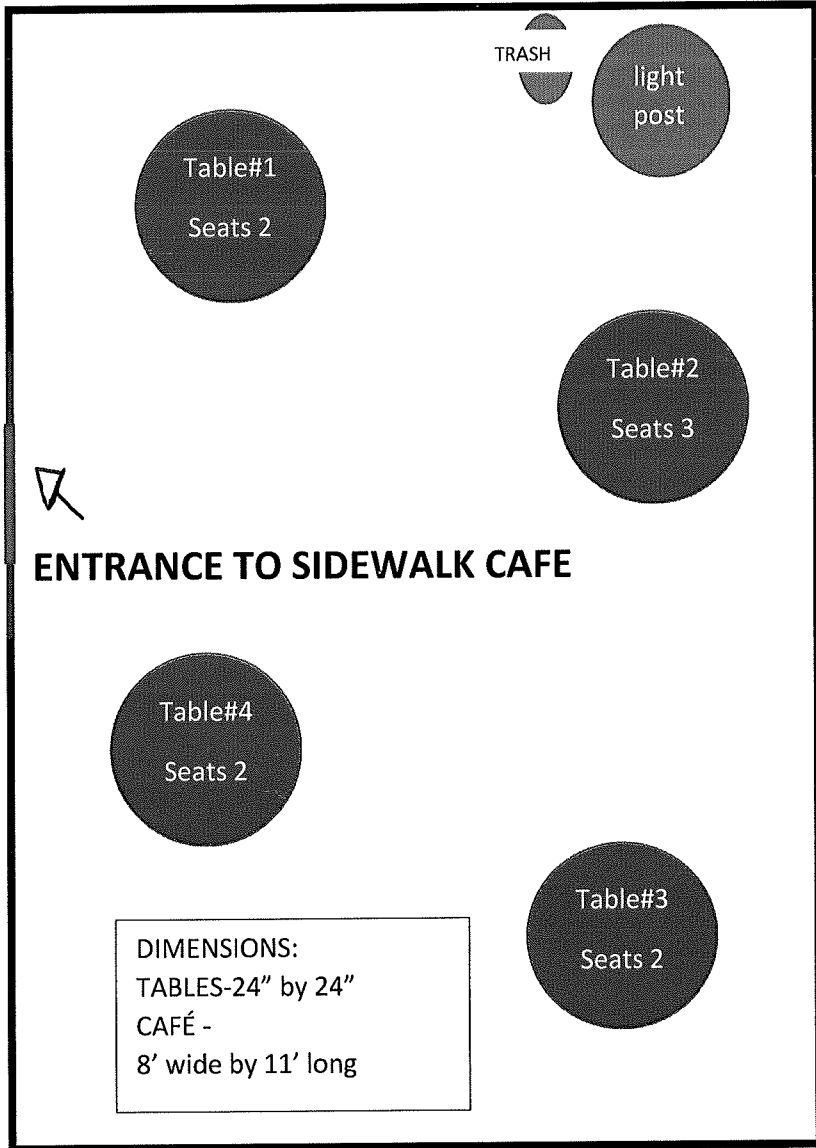

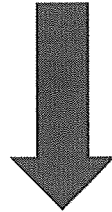
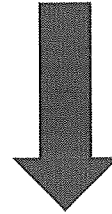
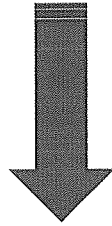
ENTRANCE TO THE SPOT
