SUMMARY:

At its meeting of June 8, 2011, the Urban Design Commission **GRANTED FINAL APPROVAL** of the Spring Harbor Middle School new greenhouse and gardens located at 1110 Spring Harbor Drive. Appearing on behalf of the project were David Ropa and Andrews Braman, both representing Spring Harbor Middle School/MMSD; and Ald. Mark Clear. This was approved as a consent item.

ACTION:

On a motion by O’Kroley, seconded by Harrington, the Urban Design Commission **GRANTED FINAL APPROVAL**. The motion was passed on a vote of (9-0).

The overall ratings for this project are 5 and 6.
