This project will CIPP line an approximately 39 foot, 8 inch diameter sanitary sewer main near Blair Street. This will be accomplished using thermal cure lining methods because the sewer main has a siphon (i.e. vertical pipe bends) and because there is groundwater infiltration into the pipe. The estimated cost of this project is\$99,250.

The Plan Commission approved the demolition of the structures, which include a 18,707 sf storage unit building, 2,479 sf office/storage building, and 968 sf office building. The site will be restored to lawn pending public engagement in 2025 to identify the future park expansion amenities. The estimated cost of this project is \$500,000.
