2025 Actual Expenditures and Encumbrances (Through January):

- Total of Actual Expenditures and Encumbrances: ~\$1,569,000
- January 2025 Actual Expenditures (~\$61,000):
 - **1.** Facilities: ~\$47,000
 - 2.Fleet/Other: ~\$11,000
 - 3. Pipelines: ~\$3,000



2025 Water Main Expense Depreciation:

- The total targeted spend amount in 2025 is \$5,000,000.
- Actual expenditures through January are ~\$5,000; immaterial but typical for this time of year, given the annual construction cycle.
- Estimated encumbrances in January are over \$600,000.



Project Update: Unit Well 19 Iron, Manganese, & Radium Treatment

- Project Budget: \$9,183,000
 - Current Status: Construction
 - Preparations for treatment tank setting and installation week of 2/24
 - Replacement of current booster pumps and related piping
 - Review of Pay Requests #4 & #5

Upcoming:

- Setting precast walls, roof for new treatment addition
- Interior mechanical, electrical, plumbing alterations







Project Update: Well 15 PFAS Treatment Facility

- Project Budget: \$5,943,000
 - Current Status: Construction
 - Filter tanks have been set, roof re-closed
 - Equipment and piping connections
 - Review of minor proposed modifications of plumbing/structural/utilities

Upcoming:

- Deep well equipment and borehole rehabilitation work (March)
- Equipment and piping connections (ongoing)





Project Update: Well 12 Reconstruction

- Project Budget: \$4,800,000 (2025: \$800,000)
 - Current Status: Planning and Analysis
 - Review and upgrades / updates to electrical plans and specs
 - Modeling analysis for construction vulnerabilities and potential added site storage
 - Updated plans and specifications for Safe Drinking Water Loan application (6/30/2025)

Upcoming:

- Final recommendations on additional storage
- Comprehensive bidding and construction services contract with SEH (through 2027)
