Hoops of Dane County General Security Policy

It does not make a difference if we have entertainment or not, our security is based on the type of crowd, the night of the week and / or how many people are predicted to attend. Our security guidelines are 1 security per 50 people.

- 1) How security personal are utilized.
 - a) Parking lots
 - b) Door ID checking
 - c) Wanding-beer and liqueur checks
 - d) Bathroom and bar checks
 - e) Floating supervisor

- 2) Control of parking lot
 - a) We have security in lot(s) at all times on nights that are busy. Customers and non-customers are not allowed to hang out in the lot or sit in their cars.

- 3) Noise and sound checks
 - a) Security will check the sound of the entertainment outside of the building and make sure it is maintaining a level inside the building.

- 4) No exit policy
 - a) On entertainment nights, we have established a no exit policy. If you exit the building, you will not re-enter unless you pay the cover charge again. If you do exit, that person will be escorted back to their car and made sure they have left the lot.

- 5) Unruly patrons
 - a) We try to defuse any situation that may arise by talking to the person and reasoning with them. If all else fails, we will call the non-emergency number if they are still present. If they leave before the police arrive, we will try to get their name, license plate number and make/model of their vehicle for the officer. We will either request an "Unruly Patron" ticket or inform the patron they will not be allowed back in for future events.

- 6) Intoxicated persons
 - a) If a patron arrives and appears to be intoxicated, they will be asked to blow into a breath meter. If they are in fact intoxicated, they will not be allowed entrance.

- 7) Security uniform
 - a) All security are required to be dressed in uniform clothing that identifies their position. At no time do we allow customers to help with any situation that may arise.

- 8) Closing time
 - a) Security is split between inside and outside. Once the inside has been cleared out, all security move outside to help the rest of the team clear and direct the parking lot(s) and the surrounding areas. They are then responsible for picking up any trash that has been left outside from the cars in the lot(s) and the streets.
