A motion was made by Hewitt, seconded by Palm, to RECOMMEND TO COUNCIL TO ADOPT - PUBLIC HEARING with the condition that the City staff work with the property owners on exploring U-turn options mid-median. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

LeAnne Hannan, City Engineering, and Yang Tao, City Transportation, presented plans and specifications. Tao noted that the assessments for the streetlights would be revised. A new assessment will go out with the Notification for the Common Council Hearing.

Hannan introduced a copy of an email from Brian Rusch.

Hannan noted that the biggest concern was from the Condo Association regarding the median in front of their condo. They would like to see some type of break in the median.

### **Public Registered:**

Kurt Young – 702 Hidden Cave – opposes. Young has concerns about the median and cars making u-turns.

Annette Konicek – 701 Hidden Cave – opposes. Konicek finds it strange that the City would go to this length with the economy the way it is and had concerns regarding trees being taken down. She does not believe that these improvements will change the traffic flow.

Tim Konicek – 701 Hidden Cave – opposes. Konicek introduced a letter with his concerns. Fails to see the rationale behind the lighting, feels the street is properly lit and believes it to be a waste of energy and money. He feels that resurfacing the street alone would be sufficient.

Lyndsay Wilson – 9362 Old Sauk Rd – representing the Blackhawk Loft Condo Association. The Condo Association supports the project as a whole, but opposes the median in front of the condos. Stated that with the incline of the

road by the buildings and the proposed median, it will cause more accidents. Wilson introduced correspondence from other Association members. She stated that instead of a left turn lane, she would like to see a break in the median.

Jim Weber – Weber Development – 1276 S Fish Hatchery Rd. – supports the project but would like to see some improvements on the medians proposed, without delaying the project.

Dave Nelson – 7259 W Old Sauk Rd – opposes. Nelson does not like the medians and had questions on the assessment calculations.

Dietner Bassuner -707 Cricket Ln - opposes. Bassuner opposes the median and believes it to be a waste of money.

Bob Elliott - 117 W Milwaukee St., Janesville WI - was registered to speak. Elliott is General Council for Woodmans. Elliott believes that the only reason that this is being done is to improve the bike trail. He doesn't believe that Woodmans is getting any special benefits from the work being proposed and should not have to pay the proposed assessment.

Dailey noted that Woodmans has been given permission to use the drainage way, it does not have an easement. He noted that Woodmans has the option to put in any size pipe they wish, or could have the work done themselves.

Alder Palm noted that the bike path and the area by Woodmans is hazardous in the winter, with icy patches, to pedestrians and bikers. The City is liable for this area and needs to make improvements.
