4. 36241 Resolutions Establishing the Ad Hoc Downtown Public Restroom Committee

### 7. Review of Downtown Public Restrooms Staff Report

Jeanne Hoffman, City Engineering, summarized the Downtown Public Restrooms Staff Report. Tom Woznick, Parking Utility, provided updates on the existing portable restroom facilities at Lake Street Campus ramp and Capitol Square North ramp. Concerns about freezing water pipes for restroom facilities open year-round were raised. The possibility of adding a public restroom with another visitor center location on or near the Capitol Square in conjunction with a future development project was also discussed. The Committee requested additional information regarding usage data for existing facilities as well as additional cost data for trailerable restrooms and heated restrooms.

# 8. <u>36396</u> Future Meeting Schedule: Time, Location and Frequency

The Committee reviewed and concurred with the Future Committee Meeting Schedule; the Committee recommended that rather than three separate meetings, the Committee's recommendations could be presented to the Business Improvement District, the Greater State Street Business Association, Downtown Madison, Inc., and possibly the Capitol Neighborhoods, Inc. at the same meeting.
