We have spent a lot of time trying to build community and under this plan would be split 3 ways. I support Concept 6. 5a would cause voting / alders / etc to be different and undo much of the work we put into getting community developed. 5a would also split the police districts

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It seems like other districts ex: 2, 4, 6 are spread over areas that are less areas of common interest. It seems <sup>especially 6</sup> better to have a small condensed area surround in the square to be together since that has more common community interests. The area of 6 around the square has less in common with the area of 6 on the far eastern edge.

I also believe the redistricting committee should have been more independent of the council consisting of community members, that have no dog in the fight. Letting legislators at any level redistrict themselves tends to end up with gerrymandered districts even if they have all good intentions. (which is sometimes doubtful). It does put into doubt fairness.

More time should also have been given to the community so ideas could have been gathered before the actual lines were drawn. It does feel the city just does input as 'window dressing' so they can say they asked. Odessa plan is case in point.

Concept 6 would maintain that connection and provide a stronger connection to downtown by increasing the coverage further west.*

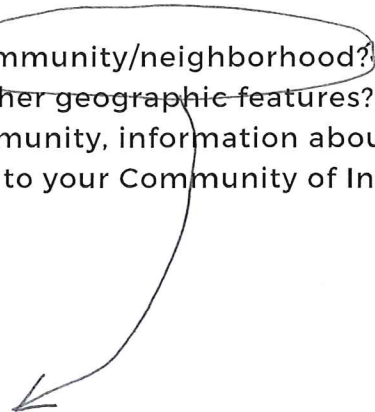

As a member of the Orchard Ridge Board. I have been aware of the relationship of the neighborhood and the Alder of the past 10 years. I feel the Orchard Ridge Neighborhood would benefit by having Alders representing the neighborhoods specified in option 6 rather than 5a. Alder district 20 in option 6 is far more homogeneous and ~~is~~ contiguous there are no freeways dividing it. This in comparison with district 10 in 5a, which is divided both by the beltline and 151, Verona Rd. Thus district 20 of option 6 has a far greater Community of Interest than district 10 of 5a.
