44793 615 Howard Place (C-10-56-2016)

Krittenbrink Architecture appealing IBC 1008.1.1. The Code notes the minimum height and width for doors. The variance requested is to allow a non-standard door for a non-required exit.

The Madison Fire Department recommends approval of the variance.

BWZ Architects appealing IBC section 503 of the 2009 IBC. The building is required to be spriklered because a portion of the building is not within 150 feet of the hydrant. The variance requested is to provide fire alarm and smoke detection systems in lieu of a sprinkler system in the new addition.

The Madison Fire Department supports the variance with conditions.
