The written training document and the policy manual shall be completed by the licensee within 45 days of the proposed conditions becoming conditions of the license and be delivered to the Madison Police Department for review and approval. Training verification shall be maintained by licensee and be available to the Madison Police Department upon request. 4. Ms. Lee shall make a concerted effort to educate herself and all employees on issues regarding chronic street alcoholics and shall work, and have all staff work, with the district officers and the neighborhood officer in their efforts to deal with the problems caused by the chronic street alcoholics. The training and police manuals shall reflect this effort. 5. Riley's shall not sell single cans or bottles of fermented malt beverages with the exception of micro brews and speciality imports. 6. The maximum capacity for the first and second floor bar areas will not exceed 190. 7. Hand-held counters shall be used by staff at the entrance after 8:00 p.m. 8. Food service shall be available at all times beginning at 11:00 a.m. 9.
