Subject: Comments on development review process for EDC

Greetings: I believe that it is very important for neighborhoods and the individuals who live in them to be involved in the development consideration process as soon as possible. Contact with neighborhood associations should be required, not just encouraged.

A neighborhood representation should participate in early meetings when the developer works with city staff.

Also, notices of hearings should reach those within 500 feet of a development, not just 200 feet, and notices should be sent one month before a hearing.

Finally, alders should be updated on changes in development plans, and they should notify residents in the area of the changes.
