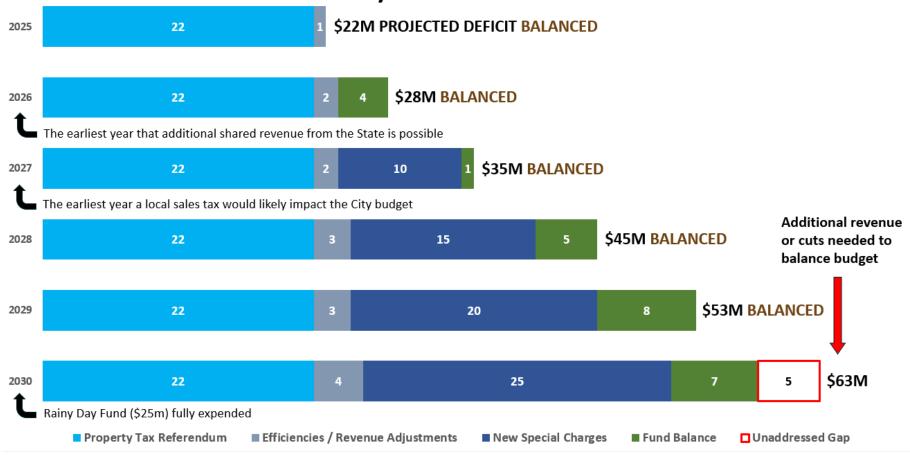

2026 Budget Information

The <u>2026 Budget website</u> will be updated as we complete each phase.

Operating Budget Cost to Continue

Cost to continue is the first step of the budget process. Finance meets with all agencies to understand what it will cost to provide the **same level of services** as the current year in the upcoming year.

- Cost to continue does include estimated personnel costs (planned COLA increases, estimated benefit rate increases), estimated debt service, contractually required costs (e.g. increases to multi-year contracts)
- Cost to continue does not include proposed expansion of services or new services or contracts

Timeline

- March 31 April 11: Finance + Agencies complete CTC analysis
- April 14 25: Finance + Agencies meet
- April 28 May 9: Finance compiles final estimates
