- **Budget:** \$1281.00
 - Decoration (\$797), Structural materials (\$77), Generator rental (\$240), advertisement (\$100), tax (\$67)

Proposed by Cheryl DeWelt

- **Proposing:** a sculpture made out of recycled bike rims signifying both sustainability and the biking community. The public will have the opportunity to decorate the sculpture further with colorful ribbons and fabrics from a box attached to the sculpture, promoting community and sustainability.
 - Sculpture will be 9 ½' by 9 ½'
- **Timeline:** installed by mid June, remain up till mid September
- **Budget:** \$1000.00
 - Bike rims, metal rods, other materials, artists labor









The Little Gallery Project:

Proposed by Rachel Bruya & Jeremy Wineberg

- **Proposing:** miniature buildings (1½'x1'x1') located near public sidewalks and in yards. The boxes will bring the gallery to the people rather than making the people come to it. The little galleries will exhibit local, professional artists on a monthly rotation.
 - Proposed locations: 1921 E. Mifflin street, 1901 Monroe street, UW-Madison campus.
- **Timeline:** installed by May 3, 2013. A continuous project
- **Budget:** \$1500.00
 - Publicity/openings (\$960), signage (\$540)

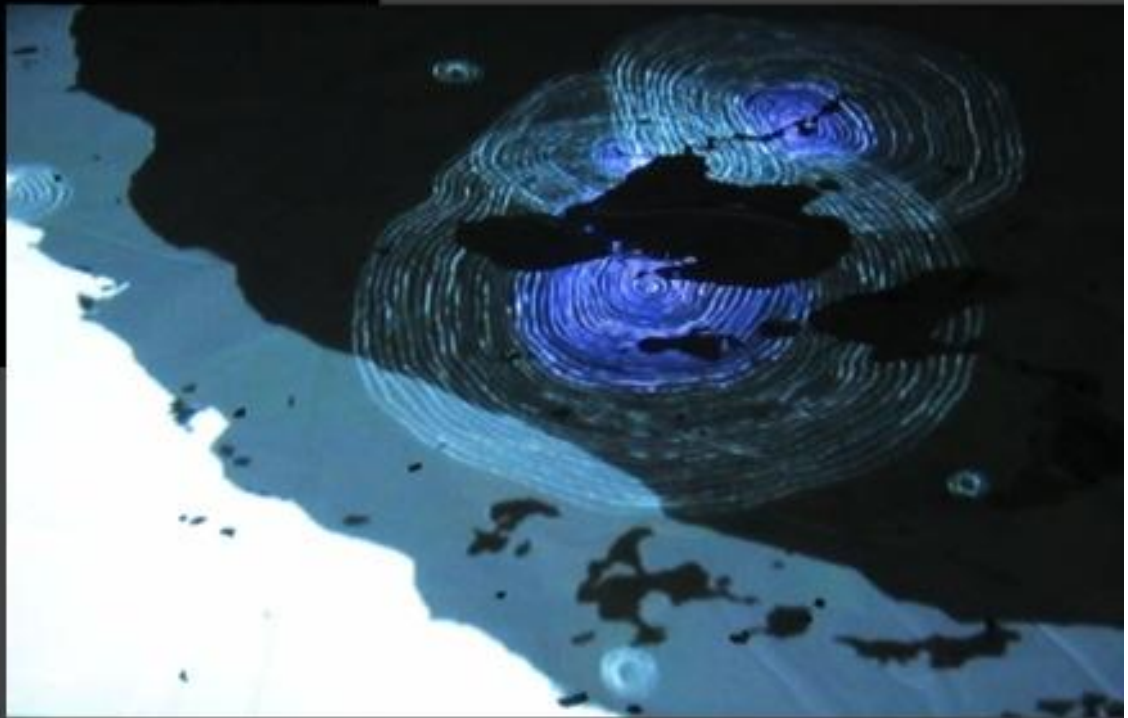
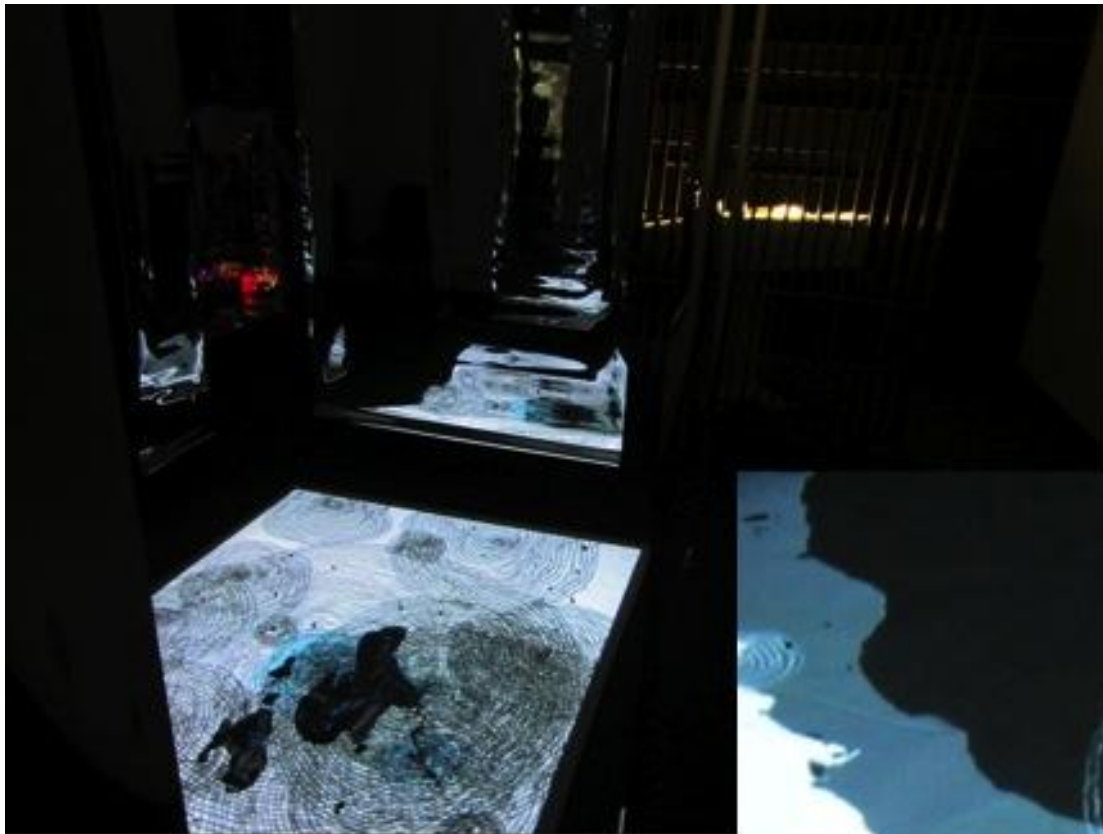

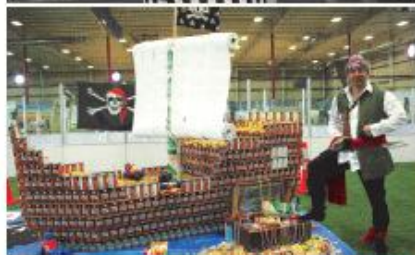
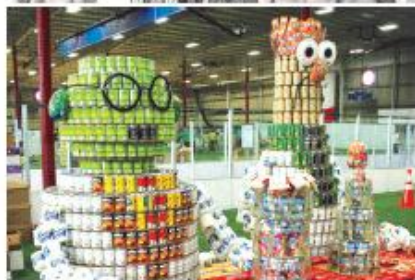
Inverted Lakes, ice sculpture
