Mendota Street and Sycamore Avenue Fiber/Conduit Project (Streets East)

The City of Madison will be extending fiber conduit in the City of Madison beginning in February and ending in March. There will be a public hearing before the City of Madison Board of Public works on Wednesday, February 8, 2012 at 5:30pm in Room 108 of the City County Building, 210 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Madison, WI.

Contractors, hired by the City of Madison, will bury the new conduit within the right of way, under the sidewalk and in the grass terrace, at the following locations:

- Beginning at the intersection of Mendota Street and East Washington Avenue running south
 east on the south east side of Mendota Street. The conduit installation will move to the north
 east side of Mendota Street near Juniper Avenue and continue until the intersection of
 Sycamore Avenue and Mendota Street.
- The conduit installation will begin again to the west side of the Walsh Road and Sycamore Avenue intersection and continue on the north side of Sycamore Avenue until it reaches the City Garage at 4602 Sycamore Avenue.

Restoration of any damage within the limits of the project, in the right of way, will be restored in accordance with the City of Madison standard specifications.
