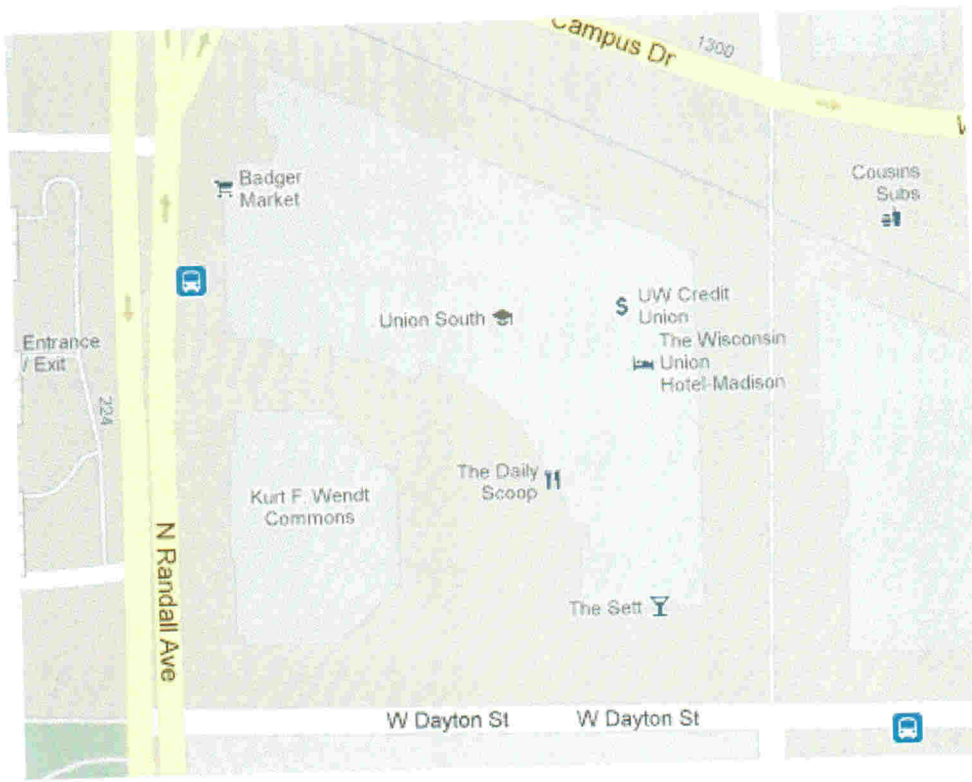

Event Schedule:

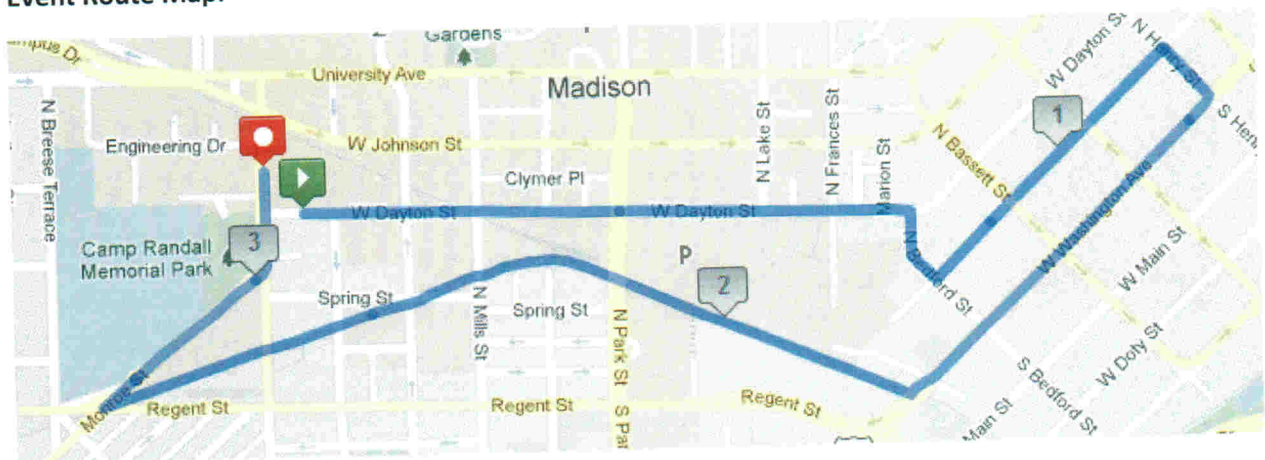
- 12:00: Set-up begins at Union South
- 13:00: Set up begins on the course
- 14:00: Police begin closing intersections as needed
- 14:30: Race Start: Skirts**
- 14:33: Race Start: Chasers**
- 14:40: All runners are through Park Street on Dayton
- 15:00: All runners are off main thoroughfares and on trail or parking lanes
- 15:30: All runners are clear of course
- 16:00: Course is clear and all roads are open and normal
- 17:30: Event hard closure

Event Site Map:



The event will take place on the Union South deck near Wendt Library. The port-o-potties, stage, band and beer garden will be completely off street and managed by Union South. The start of the race will be at the south side of the Union just east of the parking garage entry. We ask that Dayton be closed from Randall Ave to Orchard St. for the start of the race. From 14:00 to 14:45. The finish will be in the parking lane of Randall Ave just to the south of the Union Entrance on Randall Ave. The only items that will be on the street are a small start truss and a small finish truss. Both will be removed from the streets as soon as possible.

Event Route Map:



Event Route Description:

- Start: Dayton Street between Randall Ave and Orchard Street. Full closure
- East on Dayton Street until Bedford St. using eastbound lanes.
- Right (south) onto Bedford St. until Mifflin Ave. using both lanes of Bedford St. Bedford St. between Dayton St. and Mifflin St. to be closed.
- Left (east) onto Mifflin St. using the eastbound lanes of traffic until S. Henry St.
- Right (south) on S. Henry St. using the southbound lanes of traffic.
- Right (west) on W. Washington Ave. using the parking lane and one lane.
- Right (west) onto the Southwest Commuter Trail until Monroe St.
- Right (northeast) on Monroe St. using the parking lane
- Follow Monroe St into Randall Ave using the parking lane.
- Finish: Parking lane before west side entry into Union South.

All roads except Bedford St. to remain open in one direction to traffic.

****All runners will be through Dayton St. and Park St. in less than 7 minutes.**

*****Course will be coned and barricaded as needed per Engineering and PD*****

Safety and Security Plan:

Course:

The course will be monitored by a combination of Special Duty Officers, course marshals, volunteers and race staff. We will have two-way radios with a portable repeater to maintain communication. An EMT will be roaming the course. All RDE staff are trained in CPR/AED. We will have an ambulance staffed and staged at the start/finish area.

Post-Race:

The Union South will be monitoring liquor sales as part of the venue contract. All participants will be required to show a valid ID. The post-race party will be cut-off at 17:30 SHARP! There will be EMT/Medical on the location until 17:30.

Parade Permit:

A parade permit has been applied for on 3/28/13.
