

# Environmental Health Changes

# Major changes to contract

- Mobile food and temporary permits issued by the state must be recognized in agent jurisdiction
- Agent must investigate complaints from exempt facilities (but we cannot license them)
- Allows agents to assess an inspection fee
- All staff working in this program must be working towards becoming a Registered Sanitarian

# Minor changes to contract

- We must conduct unannounced inspections (some exceptions do apply)
- Agents must attend Department training, meetings and conference
- Agents must report temporary licenses issued to Department on a monthly basis

# Recent changes outside of the Contract

- Sushi – now considered seafood processing
- Certified food manager – DATCP issued certificate no longer required
- Non profits – exempt in statues, cannot license
- Recognizing the state license
  - Temporary
  - Mobiles
- Annual temporary license – cannot issue per event
- Taverns that do not sell food – exempt, can only license with rules established by ordinance
