





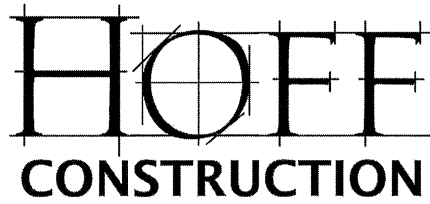

Hoff Construction's recycling plan for the demolition of the existing structure at 703 Rethke Avenue is as follows:

- Arron Mullins with Habitat for Humanity will do a walk through prior to demolition to ascertain if there are any reusable materials
- All remaining material will be loaded into dumpsters provided by Royal Container
- Concrete will be loaded into a separate dumpster and taken to Homburg in Madison for recycling
- Metal will be loaded into a separate dumpster and taken to All Metals in Madison for recycling
- The roof is comprised of rubber (not shingles), as such the roofing materials will be recycled with other materials
- All other materials will be recycled by Royal Container at their Windsor location
- A report summarizing the amount of recycled material will be issued by Royal Container to Hoff Construction at end of the demolition phase which will be forwarded to the City of Madison
- There is no re-use plan, as you can see from the attached pictures the interior of the building is down to studs and everything has been removed, most exterior windows are broken
- There are no known hazardous materials within the building
