Regarding liquor license for Irwin A. and Robert D. Goodman Community Center, Inc. license LICLIB-2011-01732:

I am issuing a new Change of Premises application to replace the previous version sent on April 16. Also attached are revised floor plans showing all premises we would like to include under this application. In addition to the 5 community rooms we would like to add in the currently licensed building, we would like to add the gymnasium and attached large multi-purpose room, plus the green space and pergola areas outdoors. We would also like to add the first floor, small courtyard outside the first floor, and three conference rooms on the second floor at the Brassworks building.

Outdoor spaces would be fenced off when alcohol is available, in compliance with City and State regulations.

Liquor service would stop at 11:00 pm at all venues, in accordance with our current license.

Total combined capacity of all venues would increase from the current 500 indoors to 1500 indoors and 500 outdoors. Capacity would vary based on the setup of the rooms. These capacity estimates are pending final occupancy permits for new and modified spaces.

As stated in our current license, alcohol may be available in these areas during special events, dinners, private rentals, and catered events. Attendance at these events is controlled through ticket sales, private invitation, or special reservation. General public walk-in access to these premises when alcohol is available is not presently allowed, nor proposed.

Alcohol is to be stored exclusively in secured cabinets and coolers with restricted access at all times.

I am also attaching an email string between myself and Eric Christianson regarding previous communication on this matter. Please let me know as soon as possible if further action is required on our part before the submission deadline.

This request for change of premises supersedes all previous versions. Please direct any questions to me. Thank you.






GOODMAN COMMUNITY CENTER BRASS WORKS
