Public Health Madison & Dane County (Public Health) proposes the acceptance of an additional \$240.00 from the State of Wisconsin Department of Health Services for Communicable Disease Control and Prevention.

The Board of Health for Madison and Dane County previously approved Resolution #85889 authorizing the acceptance of \$26,800 from the State of Wisconsin Department of Health Services for Communicable Disease Control and Prevention. Public Health received an

additional \$240.00 from the State of Wisconsin Department of Health Services, increasing the total amount to \$27,040.00.

The purpose of this grant is to support communicable disease prevention and control including disease surveillance, contact tracing, staff development and training, and other infection control measures. 


Who We Are



FTE staff – 1 Supervisor, 1 lead worker, 1 full time PHA, 1 partial FTE PHA (2, 3-hour clinics per month), 8 partial FTE RNs (3, 3hour clinics per month)

LTE staff - 2 non clinical front desk staff, 5 vaccinators – all do 0-2 clinics per month

Who We Work With



Our priority populations include:

- Uninsured/underinsured children and adults and children eligible under Vaccines for Children (VFC)
- We mostly serve adults, since most VFC-eligible kids get healthcare (including vaccines) through BadgerCare coverage
- We can provide different levels of vaccine response during outbreaks

Our Clinics

8 regular clinics per month at our South Park St and East Washington Clinics

2 mobile clinics per month – some in partnership with O'Connell Pharmacy

5 dairy farm clinics/year onsite at several farms in Dane County

COVID/Flu clinics weekly during respiratory season

Several school-based clinics during school year with SSM Health

In 2025* so far, we've given:

648 doses

To 184 children under 19

Funding Sources



Vaccines for Children (vaccine given): \$191,320

Vaccine for Adult:

- Requested Amount \$230,385
- Received Amount \$83,803.44

Public health budget: \$406,900

GAC Grant: \$112,157

Contingency planning



If 317 funds decreased: Adult vaccine would be even more limited.



If public health budget reduced: Staff reallocation, decreasing FTE (LTEs first)



If GAC grant decreased: may need to reduce frequency of mobile clinics or stop altogether, may not be able to run COVID/flu specific clinics

Cost of vaccines requested through VFA (Vaccines for Adults): \$230,000


The shortfall between requested amount and received amount:

\$147,000

If we had to buy them outside of the program, the same vaccines would cost:

\$237,000
