

AUTHORIZING THE CHANGE IN FUNDING SOURCE FOR PROJECT POSITION NUMBER  
3068

Public Health Madison & Dane County currently employs Public Health Nurses to provide home visiting services to new mothers in Dane County through the Nurse Family Partnership (NFP) program, a well-researched program that improves child health and maternal well-being.

One NFP Public Health Nurse project position was created in the 2018 budget, funded by the the Oscar Rennebohm Foundation (position number 3068). This position currently sits vacant and funds from the Oscar Rennebohm Foundation are not anticipated until later in the year.

There are currently funds available within the Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting (MIECHV) grant to immediately support the hiring of an NFP Public Health Nurse for position number 3068.

In order to facilitate the hiring of an NFP Public Health Nurse to support the current NFP caseload in Dane County, Public Health Madison and Dane County requests a change in funding source for project position number 3068, documented in the 2018 budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the 2018 budget documentation be revised to reflect that project position number 3068 be funded by MIECHV grant.
