



PUBLIC NOTICE

AT&T will be extending its fiber optic network within the City of Madison during the Month of August- mid September 2013. This work is being done in order to enhance existing facilities in the Madison Area.

There will be a public hearing, before the City of Madison Board of Public Works, on Wednesday, August 21, 2013 at 5:30 p.m. in Room 108 of the City-County Building 210 Martin Luther King Jr Blvd.

Cable installation contractors hired by AT&T will install fiber cables within the Roadway limits at the following location:

1. Work to take place on the north side of the 7000 block of Watts Rd, the west side of the 600 block of S Gammon Rd, and the north side of 6800-6900 blocks of Seybold Rd.

Cable will be directional bored and placed in the public ROW.

Restoration of any damage within the limits of the road right-of-way will be completed in accordance with the City of Madison's standard specifications. All damaged sidewalk slabs will be replaced with 5" lift concrete. All damage done to grass between sidewalk and curb will be restored with a four inch covering of black dirt and seed. All restoration required within the traveled portion of the roadway will also be completed in accordance with the City of Madison's standard specifications.
