Re: 2010 Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP) Priority List

The NTMP is a neighborhood driven process and is designed to respond to traffic issues raised and advocated by neighborhoods and residents through a petition. Locations on the list have been scored and ranked using a system that includes average weekday traffic volume (AWT), percentage of traffic over posted speed limit + 5mph (% Over PSL +5), previous three years crashes per block, bike route, pedestrian area, and school walk route. The number of projects selected also depends upon funding available.

The top scoring locations recommended by staff and that can be funded in 2010 are listed below for your review and approval.
