SUMMARY:

At its meeting of July 13, 2016, the Urban Design Commission **GRANTED FINAL APPROVAL** of the Midtown Police Station located at 4018 Mineral Point Road. Appearing on behalf of the project were Jim Brown and Mike Zuehlke, representing Engberg Anderson Architects; Capt. Jay Lengfeld and Jacob Blue, representing the Madison Police Department.

This item was approved as a consent item with the finding that all applicable standards are adequately addressed.

ACTION:

On a motion by Harrington, seconded by Slayton, the Urban Design Commission **GRANTED FINAL APPROVAL**. The motion was passed on a vote of (5-0). The motion provided that shade trees shall be installed along the western edge of the site, and the Dogwood shall be reduced and another species substituted.
