Superintendent Eric Knepp stated that the transition to spring operations is beginning. Winter rentals and permit sales are down slightly, which is expected due to the warmer conditions. The parnership with MadNorski at Elver is going well. Skating rinks and Adopt Ice rinks have done well and he thanked volunteers for their efforts and partnership. The Lake Monona Waterfront (LMW) Ad Hoc Committee will be established soon with application processes underway. Parks will send the application link to commissioners to share with those who may be interested in the project. Staff recently toured the Olin Facility and the reconstruction is going well. A July completion is planned with a target date of opening to the public being the day after Labor Day.
