#### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

86819 5001 Femrite Drive - New Building in Urban Design District (UDD) 1. (District 16)

A motion was made by Asad, seconded by McLean, to Grant Final Approval. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

 345 W Main Street - Major Amendment to an Approved Planned Development (PD) for the Construction of an Independent Living Facility for Capitol Lakes Retirement Community. (District 4)

The adisoryv motion included the following conditions:

- The elevator and stair tower overrun shall be clad in materials as the upper floor fiber cement.
- At the northwest corner of the building, along the W Main Street elevation, the lower-level blank wall shall be refined to include windows.
- The garage louvers shall be designed to be integrated into the overall wall in which they sit (i.e., flush, same color, etc.).

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The UDC recommends that these changes can be administratively reviewed/approved.

A motion was made by Asad, seconded by Klehr, to make an advisory recommendation to the Plan Commission to Approve. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

4. 86494

3915 Lien Road - New Two-Story Building with Drive-Thru in Urban Design District (UDD) 5. (District 3)

The motion included the following conditions:

- The windows on the top and bottom floors shall be aligned.
- The columns located under the drive-thru canopy and the canopies located above building entries shall be a darker color to fade into the background.
- The applicant shall continue to work with Traffic Engineering staff to make refinements to the minimize the lane width as much as possible.
- In making adjustments to meet the TOD Overlay requirements, the second floor and the canopy shall be adjusted to maintain a change in plane between the two elements.
- Further review and approval can be completed administratively, including the lighting.

A motion was made by Asad, seconded by Graham, to Grant Final Approval. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

**5.** 86796

9453 Spirit Street (formerly addressed as 305 Bear Claw Way) - Residential Building Complex. (District 9)

The advisory motion included the following condition:

- · Revise the landscape plan to reflect taller landscape plantings to screen the headlights of the surface parking area adjacent to Building 2.
- Remove the four parking stalls adjacent to the open space, if they are not required to meet minimum parking requirements in the Zoning Code.
- · Further review and approval can be completed administratively.

A motion was made by Klehr, seconded by Asad, to make an advisory recommendation to the Plan Commission to Approve, with conditions. The motion passed by voice vote/other.
