Street Use Permit Application Items

Event Schedule:Last summer, residents in the Hammersley-Theresa Terrace neighborhood decided to hold Kids Activity Days each Monday afternoon on Theresa Terrace, to provide activities for the many children in the neighborhood who are not served by a community center or other summer programming. These events were well-attended (40-70 children per week) and well-received by the neighborhood. Residents are interested in repeating these "block parties" this summer. A city-funded summer activity program for K-5th graders will be running at Falk School from June 24 to August 9, so the Kids Activity Days on Theresa Terrace will be limited to the weeks before and following that program. These will be open to a wider variety of ages than the program at Falk, and they will provide an opportunity for contact between parents and children in the neighborhood and staff/representatives of the summer program at Falk.

Kids Activity Days are currently planned for June 17, June 24, August 12, August 19, and August 26, from 2:00 to 4:00 PM. Street barriers would go up just before 2:00 and come down as soon as clean-up is completed after 4:00 PM.

Adult volunteers from the neighborhood, the operator of the summer childrens program, and nearby neighborhood associations and churches will lead activities and supervise the activities in the blocked-off street. Clean and Freshies will provide assistance with set-up, clean-up, and assistance during the event.

Notification Schedule:This block of Theresa Terrace is a no-parking zone. We will include information on outreach flyers that notifies residents that the street will be unavailable for driving and getting in and out of driveways from 2-4 PM on the above dates.

Trash/Recycling Plan:We will have 2-4 bins set along the street during activities, for trash and recycling. Clean and Freshies and other volunteers will clean up at the end of the activities.

Safety and Security Plan: The neighborhood police officer will be notified of each event and his advice will be sought in planning. There will be a strong adult presence on the street, including multiple adults with working phones to call 911 in case of emergency or serious disturbance. We will also have the non-emergency number and neighborhood officer's phone number to use as appropriate.

Marketing of event: We will knock on doors and distribute flyers to the target area for this event, including Theresa Terrace, Hammersley Rd, Bettys Lane, Jacobs Way, Lucy Lane, Frisch Rd, Loreen Dr, and Prairie Rd.

Media coverage: None is expected.
