Dear Brian;

Your one-lot certified survey of property located at 654 Williamson Street, Section 13, Township 07N, Range 09E, City of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, is hereby **conditionally approved**. The property is zoned TE (Traditional Employment district). The conditions of approval from the reviewing agencies to be satisfied prior to final approval and recording of the CSM are:

1. Enter into a City / Developer agreement for the required infrastructure improvements. Agreement to be executed prior to sign off. Allow 4-6 weeks to obtain agreement. Contact City Engineering to schedule the development and approval of the plans and the agreement. (MGO 16.23(9)c)
2. Construct sidewalk, terrace, curb & gutter and pavement to a plan as approved by City Engineer
3. Madison Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD) charges are due and payable prior to Engineering sign-off, unless otherwise collected with a Developer's / Subdivision Contract. Contact Mark Moder (608-261-9250) to obtain the final MMSD billing a minimum of two (2) working days prior to requesting City Engineering signoff. (MGO 16.23(9)(d)(4))
4. A minimum of two (2) working days prior to requesting City Engineering signoff on the plat/csm contact either Tim Troester (West) at 261-1995 (ttroester@cityofmadison.com) or Brenda Stanley (East) at 608-261-9127 (bstanley@cityofmadison.com) to obtain the final stormwater utility charges that are due and payable prior to sub-division of the properties. The stormwater utility charges (as all utility charges) are due for the previous months of service and must be cleared prior to the land division (and subsequent obsolesces of the existing parcel). (POLICY)

5. Grant a Public Sidewalk Easement to the City on the face of this Certified Survey Map along Williamson Street and Blount Street, the width and location of the easement shall be approved by City Engineering and Traffic Engineering.

Contact Julius Smith (jsmith4@cityofmadison.com) with Engineering Mapping for the final easement language to be placed on the Face of the Map.

6. Confirm the 100' width and location of Williamson Street from Block 126. Note the legal descriptions for Document Nos. 849712 and 832632 are written based off of the location the Northwest line of Block 126. No recent resurveys have clearly accounted nor confirmed this.
7. Wisconsin Administrative Code A-E 7.08 identifies when Public Land System (PLS) tie sheets must be filed with the Dane County Surveyor's office. The Developer's Surveyor and/or Applicant must submit copies of any required U.S. public land survey monument record provided to the County Surveyor's Office, or, in instances where a public the monuments and witness ties area recovered under A-E 7.08(1g), the Surveyor shall provide to the City of Madison monument condition reports (with current tie sheet attached) for all Public Land Survey monuments, including center of sections of record, used in this survey, to Julius Smith (JSmith4@cityofmadison.com) of City Engineering, Land Information.
8. Prior to Engineering final sign-off by main office for Plats or Certified Survey Maps (CSM), the final Plat or CSM in pdf format must be submitted by email transmittal to Engineering Land Records Coordinator Julius Smith (jsmith4@cityofmadison.com) for final technical review and approval. This submittal must occur a minimum of two working days prior to final Engineering Division sign-off.
9. Update street name to S. Blount Street
10. The existing building tie language is slightly confusing along the Southeast and it can not be determined along the Northwest if the building is over or clear of the line. This CSM is to allow for the concurrent proposed development. Remove the existing building ties and label the structure to be demolished.
11. Label Lot 8, 10 and 14 in Block 125. Label Block 126
12. Per SS. 236.34 (1m)(c) "CERTIFIED SURVEY MAP" shall be printed on the map in prominent letters on each sheet with the location of the land by government lot, recorded private claim, quarter-quarter section, section, township, range and county noted.

For the Caption on the top of each sheet Removed the extra D in Recordeddd. include Government Lot 5 in front of the SW-SE and Government Lot 4 in front of the SE-SW

13. Correct/edit/or adjust legend to comply with the () symbol being labeled as "Recorded as" to with in accordance with SS. 236.20(2)(c)
14. Correct the disruption of the line from the True Center of Section to the True South 1/4 Corner of fractional Section 13, not show Mon.- Mon. = but Computed.

15. Include the Caption above the legal description in the Surveyors Certificate.

Add ... a distance of ... prior to 165.96 feet in the third line of the written legal description.

Correct the final distance call of 98.33 feet to 92.40 feet.

16. Submit to Jule Smith, prior to Engineering sign-off of the subject plat, one (1) digital CADD drawing in a format compatible with AutoCAD. The digital CADD file(s) shall be referenced to the Dane County Coordinate System and shall contain, at minimum, the list of items stated below, each on a separate layer/level name. The line work, preferably closed polylines for lot lines, shall be void of gaps and overlaps and match the final recorded plat:

a) Right-of-Way lines (public and private)

b) Lot lines

c) Lot numbers

d) Lot/Plat dimensions

e) Street names

f) Easement lines (i.e. all shown on the plat including wetland & floodplain boundaries.)

NOTE: This Transmittal is a separate requirement from the required Engineering Streets Section for design purposes. The Developer/Surveyor shall submit new updated final plat, electronic data for any changes subsequent to any submittal

17. The applicant shall dedicate Right of Way or grant a Public Sidewalk Easement for and be responsible for the construction of a five (5)-foot wide sidewalk, eight (8)-foot terrace, and additional one (1) foot for maintenance along Williamson Street.

Please contact Kathleen Kane of the Parks Division at (608) 261-9671 if you have questions regarding the following four (4) items:

18. Park Impact Fees (comprised of the Park Infrastructure Impact Fee, per MGO Sec. 20.08(2)), and Park-Land Impact Fees, per MGO Sec. 16.23(8)(f) and 20.08(2) will be required for all new residential development associated with this project. This development is within the East Park-Infrastructure Impact Fee district. Please reference ID# 23016 when contacting Parks about this project.

19. The following note should be included on the CSM: "LOTS WITHIN THIS SUBDIVISION ARE SUBJECT TO IMPACT FEES THAT ARE DUE AND PAYABLE AT THE TIME BUILDING PERMIT(S) ARE ISSUED."

20. The Parks Division shall be required to sign off on this CSM.

21. Prior to approval sign-off by the Office of Real Estate Services ("ORES"), the Owner's Certificate(s) on the CSM shall be executed by all parties of interest having the legal authority to do so, pursuant to Wis. Stats. 236.21(2)(a). Said parties shall provide documentation of legal signing authority to the notary or authentication attorney at the time of execution. The title of each certificate shall be consistent with the ownership interest(s) reported in the most recent title report. A PDF of the CSM containing electronic signatures shall be provided to ORES to obtain approval sign-off.
22. Prior to CSM approval sign-off, an executed and notarized or authenticated certificate of consent for all mortgagees/vendors shall be included following the Owner's Certificate(s). If a mortgage or other financial instrument is reported in record title, but has been satisfied or no longer encumbers the lands or ownership within the CSM boundary, a copy of a recorded satisfaction or release document for said instrument shall be provided prior to CSM approval sign-off.
23. If any portion of the lands within the CSM boundary are subject to an Option to Purchase or other Option interest, include a Certificate of Consent for the option holder and have it executed prior to CSM sign-off if said ownership interest meets the criteria set forth by Wis. Stats. Sec. 236.34 and Sec. 236.21(2)(a).
24. A Consent of Lessee certificate shall be included on the CSM for all tenant interests in excess of one year, recorded or unrecorded, and executed prior to CSM sign-off.
25. The lands within the CSM boundary abut TID 36, a Tax Incremental Financing District. Discussions with Joe Gromacki, the City of Madison's tax increment financing coordinator, may be necessary before recording the CSM if a TIF application is required. Mr. Gromacki can be reached at 608-267-8724 or jgromacki@cityofmadison.com. Please inform Andy Miller in the City's Office of Real Estate Services (acmiller@cityofmadison.com) if a TIF Loan has been authorized for the project.
26. As of April 28, 2023, the 2022 real estate taxes are paid for the subject property. Per 236.21(3) Wis. Stats. and 16.23(5)(g)(1) Madison General Ordinances, the property owner shall pay all real estate taxes that are accrued or delinquent for the subject property prior to CSM recording. Receipts from the City of Madison Treasurer are to be provided before or at the time of sign-off.
27. As of April 28, 2023, special assessments are reported. All known special assessments are due and payable prior to CSM approval sign-off. If special assessments are levied against the property during the review period and prior to CSM approval sign-off, they shall be paid in full pursuant to Madison General Ordinance Section 16.23(5)(g)1.
28. Pursuant to Madison City Ordinance Section 16.23(5)(g)(4), the owner shall furnish an updated title report via email to Andy Miller in the ORES (acmiller@cityofmadison.com), as well as the survey firm preparing the proposed CSM. The report shall search the period subsequent to the initial title report, dated January 31, 2023, submitted with the CSM application and include all associated documents that have been recorded since the initial title report. A title commitment may be provided, but will be considered only as supplementary information to the title report update. Surveyor shall update the CSM with the most recent information reported in the title update. ORES reserves the right to impose additional conditions of approval in the event the title update contains changes that warrant revisions to the CSM.

29. Include a complete and accurate legal description of the lands that are to be included in the proposed CSM. The legal description shall be reconciled with the legal description of said lands in record title. Correct the typo in the word "recorded" at the top of each CSM Sheet.

Specific questions regarding the comments or conditions contained in this letter should be directed to the commenting agency.

A resolution approving the CSM and authorizing the City to sign it and any other documents related to the proposed land division was reviewed and approved by the Common Council at its May 16, 2023 meeting.

Prior to City Engineering final sign-off by the main office of the CSM, the final CSM shall be submitted to the Engineering Division Surveyor/ Land Records Coordinator for final technical review and approval. This submittal must occur a minimum of two working days prior to final Engineering Division signoff. E-mail submittal of the final CSM in PDF form is preferred. Transmit to Jule Smith (jsmith4@cityofmadison.com).

As soon as the comments and conditions have been satisfied, the original along with the revised Certified Survey Map, with all signatures and approvals from the reviewing agencies, shall be brought to this office for final signoff. You or your client may then record the certified survey at the Dane County Register of Deeds. For information on recording procedures and fees, contact the Register of Deeds at (608) 266-4141.

Any appeal from this action, including the conditions of approval, must be filed with the Circuit Court within 30 days from the date of this letter. **The approval of this CSM shall be null and void if not recorded in twelve (12) months from the date of the approving resolution or this letter, whichever is later.**
