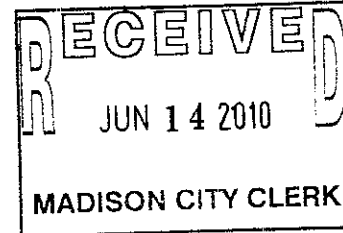

Dear Alcohol License Review Committee,

On behalf of High Point Church and High Point Christian School, in reference to the application for an alcohol license of Chetan LLC, dba Swagat Indian Restaurant, we would like to make the following statements:

- According to the City Clerks Office, the Oliva Italian and Mediterranean Restaurant, which is located in the same shopping center, has a beer and wine license. We would be much more comfortable if a Class B beer and wine license were issued to the Swagat Indian Restaurant rather than a Class B liquor and beer license.
- As a future precaution, we would like to request that a condition of the license is that the establishment maintains the definition of a restaurant in accordance with Section 38.02 of the Madison General Ordinance.
- We would like the establishment to notify both High Point Church and High Point Christian School in writing at least two weeks in advance of any request to change the license premise.

We are not opposed to Swagat Indian Restaurant serving beer or wine with a meal, but we would like these provisions included to protect our future interests. This would be especially true if the establishment changed hands or management in the future. We have over 200 children from pre-school through the 8th grade at High Point Christian School, and we would like to ensure their safety and welfare.
