

# Application for Change of Licensed Premise

\$25 non-refundable filing fee is charged at time of application. Complete application is due at 12 noon two weeks before ALRC meeting. Applicants must appear before the ALRC.

Please contact City Zoning (MMB LL-100, 608-266-4560). A Conditional Use Permit may be required.

- Detailed floor plans (no larger than 8 1/2 x 14) must accompany this form, or the request will not be presented to the ALRC.
- Orange sign- You must display the public notice sign within three days of your application at the current premise until the Common Council makes a final determination.

Prior to your appearance before the Alcohol License Review Committee (ALRC), you must contact

- The Alderperson of the District in which you intend to do business.
- The representative of the appropriate neighborhood association (if any).
- The Madison Police Department.

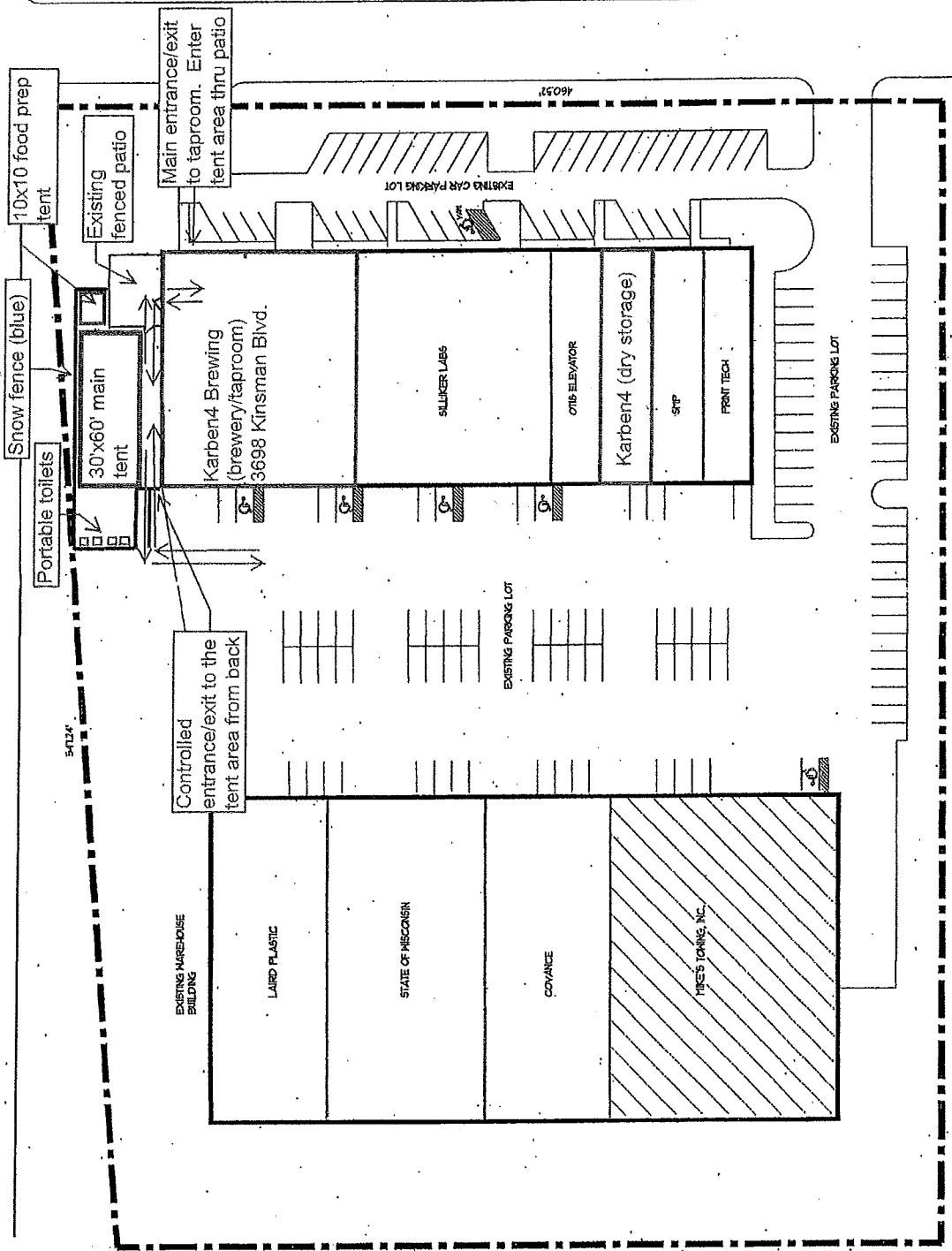

**Event Description:**

Beer/Distiller Festival -- Outside of Karben4 Brewing underneath 30x60ft tent on September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2013.

This will be an all Madison area event – we plan to presell tickets, and we’re only making 200 available in an effort to keep it small, intimate and controlled in year 1. We have invited 11 local breweries and distilleries to participate. Each company will occupy a 6 ft. table in which they will offer guests samples of their respective products – similar to many other local beer, wine, and distiller festivals around Madison. Topsy Cow will be onsite providing inexpensive, festival appropriate food to the attending patrons. We have also commissioned a 6 piece bluegrass band to provide guests additional entertainment.

Venue: On grassy area to the side of Karben4. A tent will be set-up on the north side of patio.

Event Hours: 3pm-6pm

We have hired 4 off-duty police officers to provide security. In addition, we will have a staff of 10 people working/monitoring the festival.
