5. <u>47837</u> Landmarks Commission Historic Preservation Plan Status Report

Bailey provided a memorandum from the Wisconsin Historical Society regarding the interpretation of the recently enacted commission review legislation. She said that the updated information is in line with how the Landmarks Commission has interpreted the statute language.

7. <u>54302</u> Buildings Proposed for Demolition - 2019

By unanimous consent, the Landmarks Commission voted to recommend to the Plan Commission that the buildings at 3630 Johns St and 54 Merlham Dr have no known historic value. The motion passed by voice vote/other.
