SUMMARY:

At its meeting of September 24, 2008, the Urban Design Commission **GRANTED FINAL APPROVAL** of a master plan update/revision and modifications to a Planned Commercial Site (The Villager Mall) located at 2202-2224 South Park Street, in Urban Design District No. 7. Appearing on behalf of the project was Mark Olinger, Executive Director of the City's Community Development Authority. Olinger gave an overview of the changes, which included: moving a drive entrance and reorienting parking near Hughes Place, adding two "tabletops" to emphasize pedestrian connections, setting back all building on Park Street by a minimum of thirteen feet, and removing the drive isle associated with the curb cut south of the proposed Urban League building (but preserving the curb cut for right-in/right-out movements). He also noted that remnant curb cuts along Ridgewood Way will be removed.

The Commission discussed the potential of adding a second row of trees south of the proposed Urban League Building between the sidewalk and the parking lot.

ACTION:

On a motion by Woods, seconded by Slayton, the Urban Design Commission GRANTED FINAL **APPROVAL** of a master plan update/revision and modifications to a Planned Commercial Site (The Villager Mall) located at 2202-2224 South Park Street, in Urban Design District No. 7.

The motion passed on a vote of (7-0-1) with Luskin abstaining.

After the Commission acts on an application, individual Commissioners rate the overall design on a scale of 1 to 10, including any changes required by the Commission. The ratings are for information only. They are not used to decide whether the project should be approved. The scale is 1 = complete failure; 2 = critically bad; 3 = very poor; 4 = poor; 5 = fair; 6 = good; 7 = very good; 8 = excellent; 9 = superior; and 10 = outstanding. The overall ratings for this project are 6, 6, 7, 7, 7, 7 and 8.
