With the merger, Public Health—Madison and Dane County will be contracting with the State for these same services. With the 2008 contract, the State is asking the Department to extend partner counseling and referral services to Adams, Columbia, Iowa, Richland, and Sauk Counties. The expenditures required to extend these services are included in the 2008 Adopted Operating Budget, with all costs for providing these services in other counties covered by the grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Health for Madison and Dane County on behalf of Public Health—Madison and Dane County is authorized to accept up to \$45,000 from the Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services Division of Public Health for HIV Prevention Services for the period of January 1, 2008 to December 31, 2008 to be used for program expenses and authorizing the Public Health Director to sign on behalf of Public Health—Madison and Dane County.
