This project will disturb over one acre of land, which will require a WRAPP from the Department of Natural Resources and an Erosion Control/Stormwater Management Permit from City Engineering. (Glen Yoerger, City Engineering)

# 6. University/Highland/Van Hise/Walnut Reconstruction

This project will disturb over one acre of land, which will require a WRAPP from the Department of Natural Resources and an Erosion Control/Stormwater Management Permit from City Engineering. (Glen Yoerger, City Engineering)

#### 18. Junction Rd Relief Storm Sewer

This project will disturb over 4,000 square feet, but less than one acre, which will require an Erosion Control/Stormwater Management Permit from City Engineering only. (Max Conway, City Engineering)

#### 19. Tenney Park Pavillion

This project will disturb over 10,000 square feet (but less than one acre) on the bank of a navigable waterway, which will require an Individual Chapter 30 permit for grading by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and an Erosion Control/Stormwater Management Permit from City Engineering. (Tom Maglio, City Parks)
