This project involves the remodeling of an existing workshop into an attendant's office on Level 2. The office will include the addition of an ADA handicap accessible staff toilet room. This work includes general construction items, HVAC, plumbing, and electrical construction. The area of this project is approximately 420-square feet. Estimated cost of this project is \$60,000.00. PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT - PUBLIC CONTRACT

28. <u>01080</u>

Improvements accepted for Annual Construction & Reconstruction of Concrete Sidewalk & Incidental Concrete Curb & Gutter Work Ordered (District 5) by the Common Council, Contract No. 5479. (5th AD)

Net change by change order is 64.90% (Fehrman Constr.). The initial contract was for Ordered Sidewalk in the 5th Aldermanic District in 2003. The contractor completed the work early, and was able to perform work in the 12th Aldermanic District in 2003. Change order #1 was issued for the additional 2003 work. The 12th Aldermanic District was not completed in 2003, quantities were much higher than expected. In 2004 change order #2 was issued to complete the work in Aldermanic District #12.

29. **01081**

Improvements accepted for Troy Drive Sanitary Sewer Project, Contract No. 5426. (18th AD)

Net change by change order is 14.48% (Speedway Sand & Gravel). The original plan was modified due to a conflict with the existing water main and to eliminate one sanitary main. The grade of the proposed sanitary sewer was raised to avoid the water conflict, which resulted in the reduced pipe price and cost savings to the City. The limits of construction were expanded to eliminate 285' of sanitary main on the north side of Troy Dr., which will result in lower future costs to operate and maintain the sanitary sewer system. The change order compensated the contractor for the additional work associated with the revised limits.
