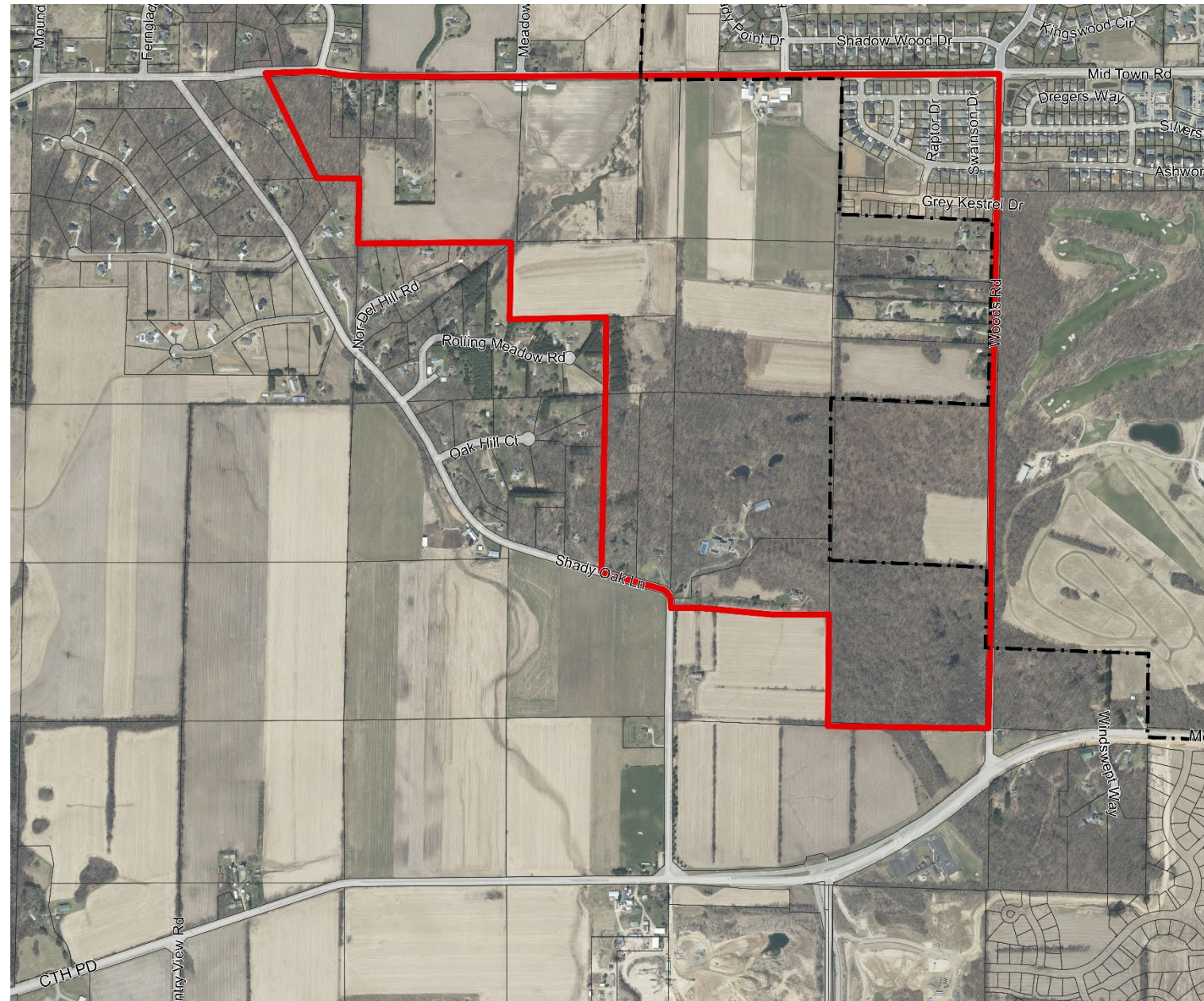

Background

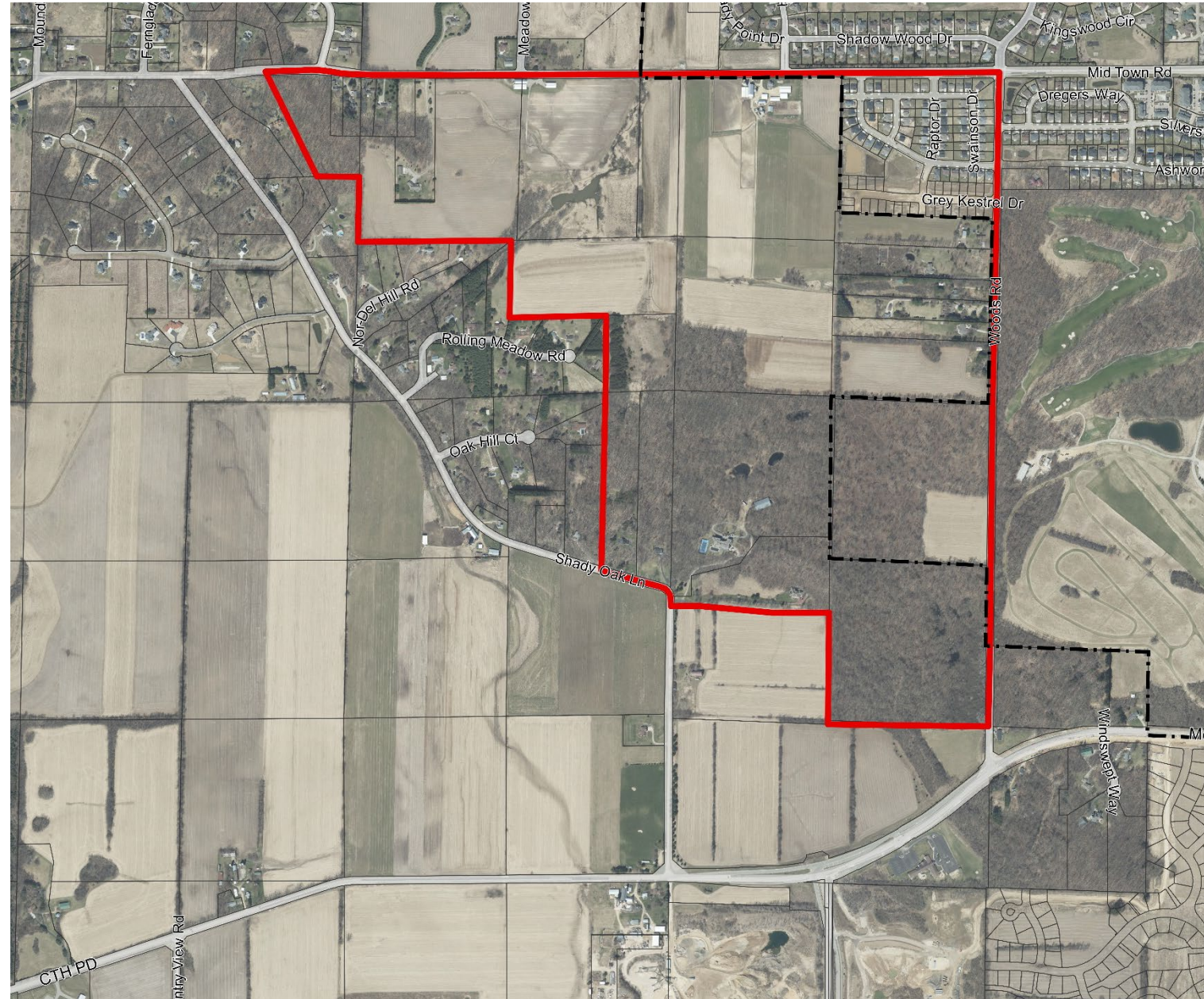
- Approximately 435 acres

- Ice Age Trail is planned to run through this area
- Madison Metropolitan School District & Verona Area School District

Draft Plan addresses:

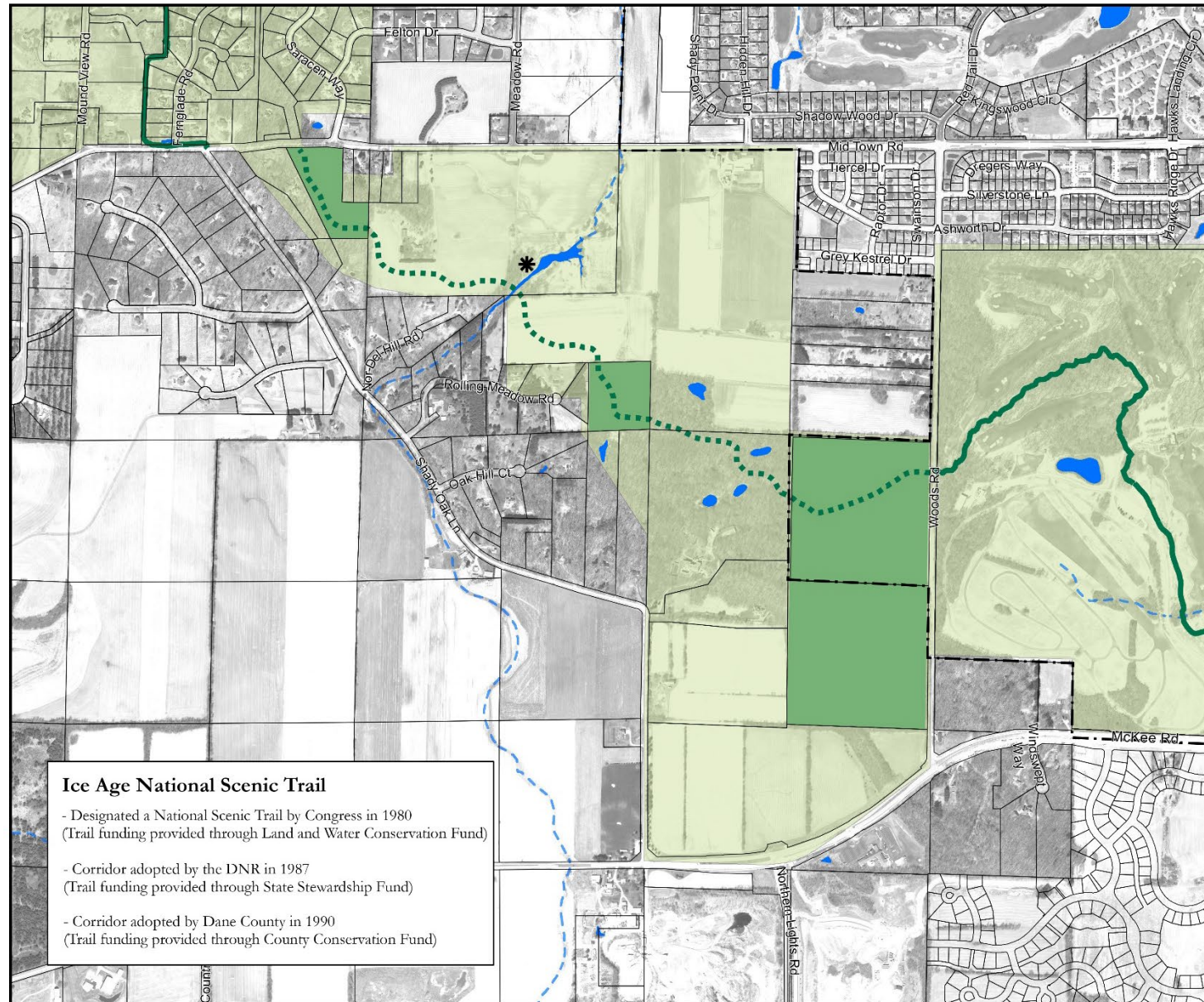
- Land uses and housing types

Shady Wood Neighborhood Development Plan

Ice Age National Scenic Trail

- Authorized in 1980 as a National Scenic Trail by Congress
- The 1,100-mile trail follows the farthest southern extent of the most recent glacial advance
- One of eight National Scenic Trails within the US

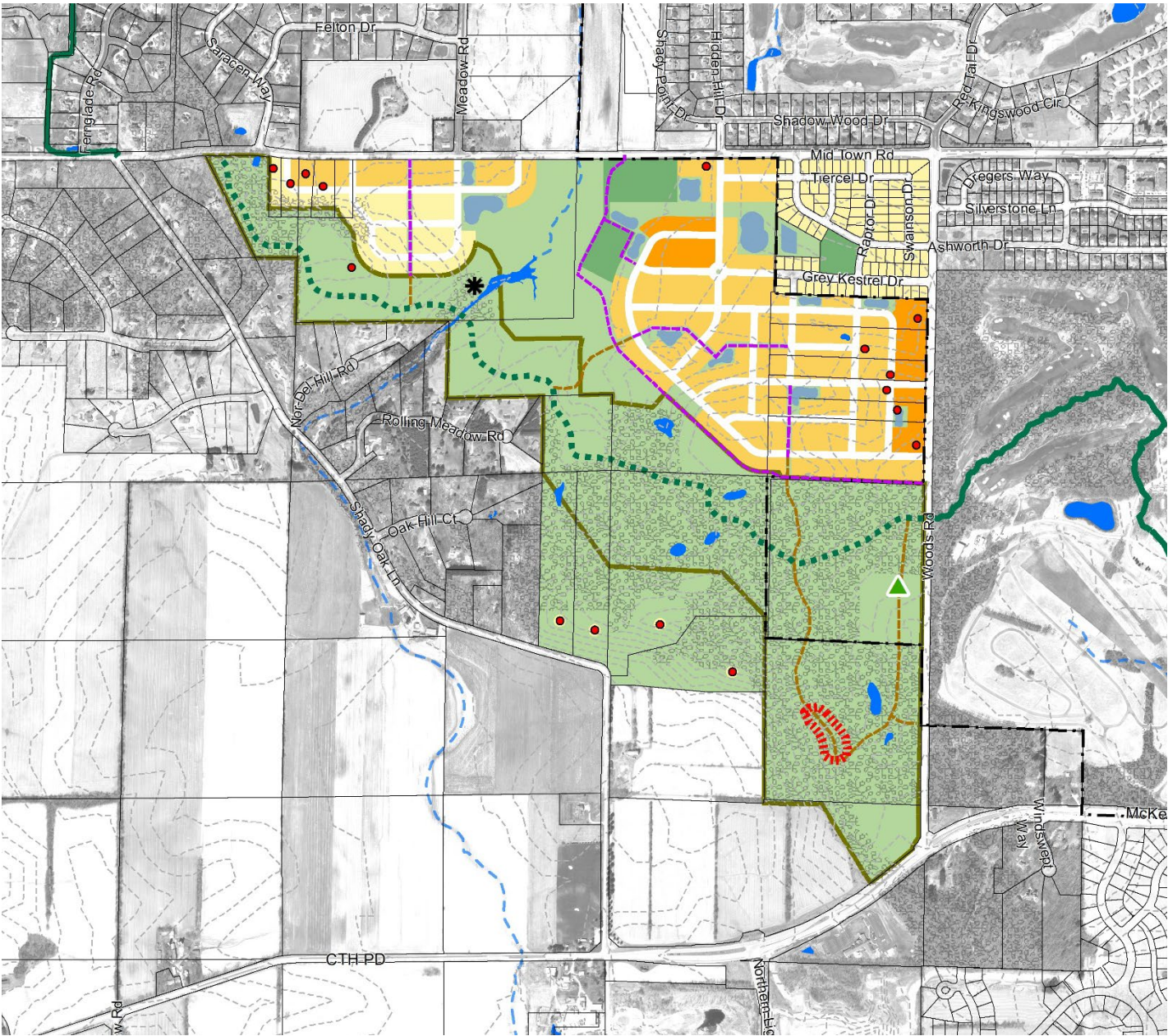

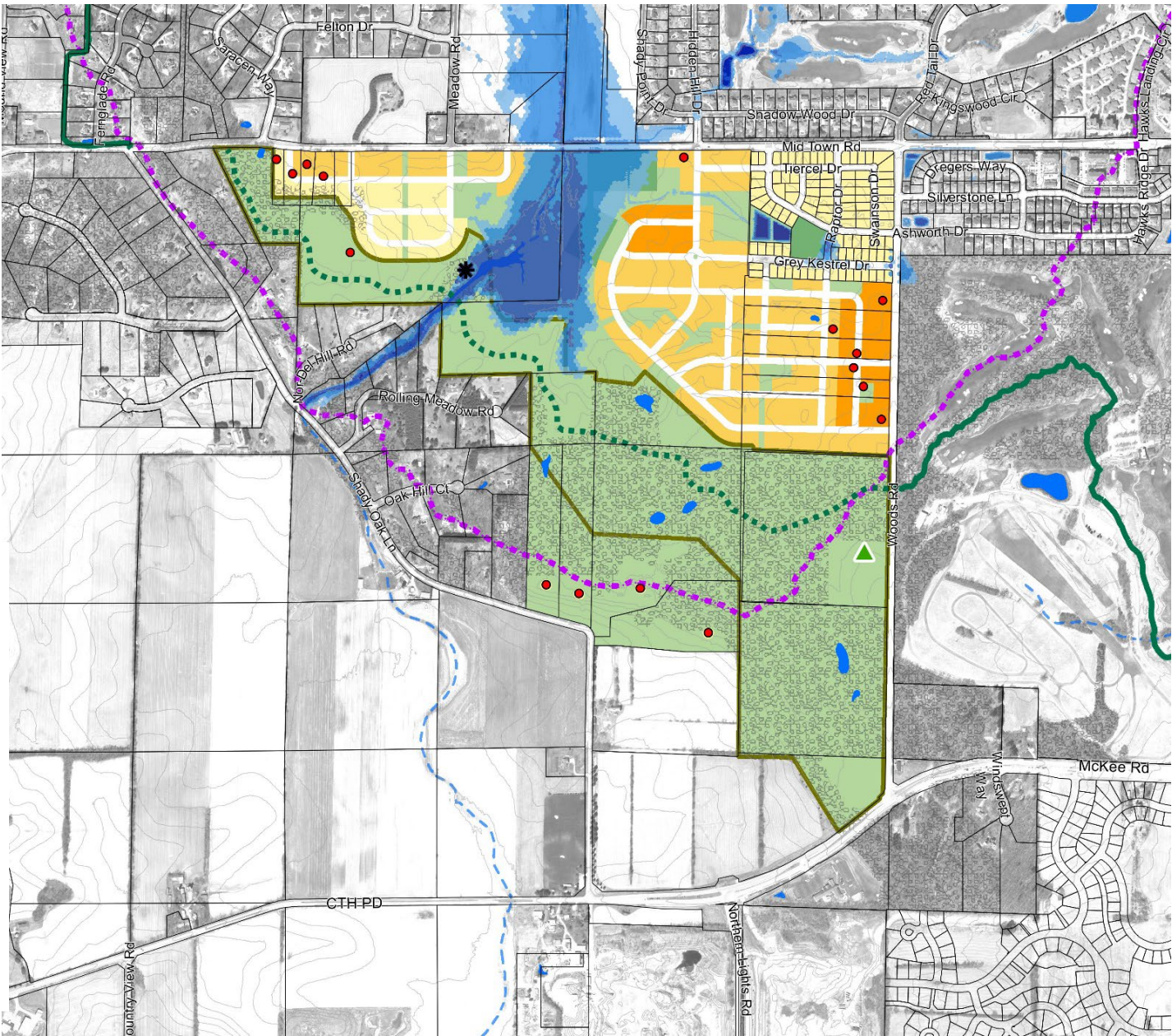
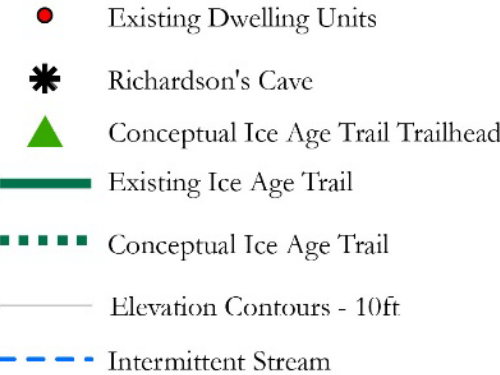
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Map 13: Storm Inundation Model

Projected Water Depths for 100-Year Flood

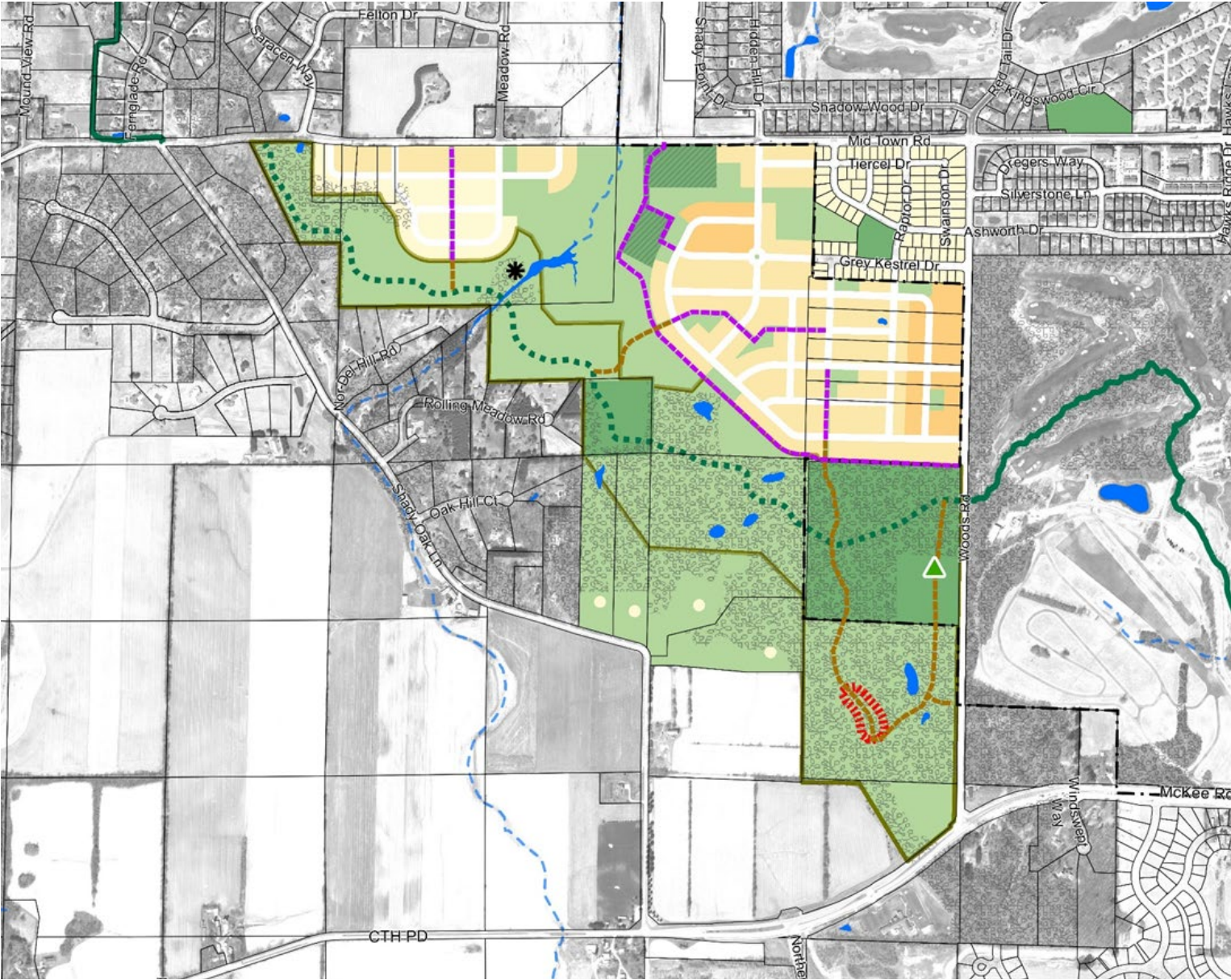
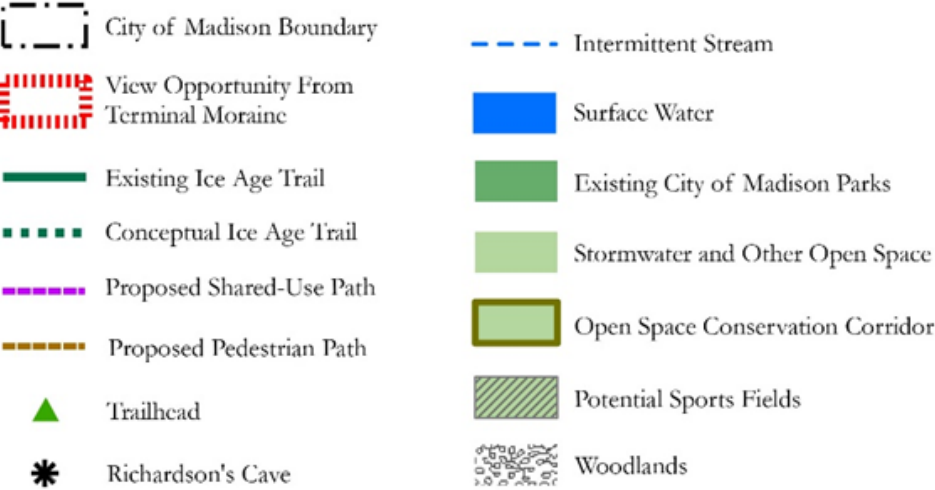


Lower Badger Mill Creek Sub-Watershed Boundary
