In previous years, both the Dane County Division of Public Health and Madison Department of Public Health conducted emergency preparedness planning that was coordinated by each of their Emergency Preparedness Coordinators. With the creation of Public Health—Madison and Dane County these two programs have been merged. The position of Coordinator on the City side of the Department is vacant. The Department does not need two coordinators, but it will need staff to assist with this program. With this resolution this position would be reduced to 0.5 FTE and reclassed as a Community Relations Specialist, combining it with a 0.5 FTE who is currently in that position. The remaining funds will be moved into LTE salaries. The net impact of these changes are to reduce Public Health's FTEs by 0.5 FTE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the existing vacant 1.0 FTE Emergency Preparedness Coordinator in the Board of Health for Madison and Dane County is eliminated and that the existing Community Relations Specialist position be increased from 0.5 FTE to 1.0 FTE
