The City of Madison Parks Division is presently working on plans and specifications for the reconstruction of it's Goodman Park Maintenance Facility. The project is expected to take around 14 months to complete. During construction, some of our maintenance staff will still be working out of other buildings on the site. The construction project will demolish the only restroom facilities in the complex. By code, in order for our maintenance staff to continue working out of the facility we need to have restrooms available to them. To this end, we have sent out a competitive change order to five general contractors presently under contract with the City of Madison for the construction of a men's and woman's restroom addition to one of our remaining buildings (building "D") at the Goodman Park Parks Division Maintenance Facility. The restrooms will be used by our maintenance staff during the 14 months of construction (Miron, Daniels, Bachmann, Bauer & Raether, Tri-North). The bids, in the form of a change order, are due April 18th at 4:00 PM. A representative of the Parks Division will be at the meeting to present the bids and to answer any questions with request for approval of the low bidder.
