



PUBLIC NOTICE

Kentucky Data Link (KDL) will be extending its fiber optic network within the City of Madison within the next couple months, January and February, 2009. This work is being done in order to provide data delivery services in the Madison Area.

There will be a public hearing, before the City of Madison Board of Public Works, on Wednesday, December 17, 2008 at 5:30 p.m. in Room 108 of the City-County Building, 210 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Madison, WI.

Cable installation contractors hired by KDL will install buried fiber optic cable within the roadway limits at the following location:

1. Beginning on the north side of Helgesen Drive, east of E. Stoughton Rd (East Frontage Rd) 850' then going west 300' across STH 51 to W. Stoughton Rd (West Frontage Rd) north 1350' along the east side of the frontage road to Allis Ave.,. On the south side of Allis Ave west 1800' to Shaffer Ave, then north 175' along the west side of Shaffer Ave to an existing utility pole 27H3-C5..
2. Beginning on the south side of Helgesen Drive, east of E. Stoughton Rd (East Frontage Rd) 500' then going west 300' to E. Frontage Rd then south 800' along the west side of the E. Frontage Road then 300' across STH 51 to W. Stoughton Rd (West Frontage Rd) south 900' along the east side of the frontage road to Pflaum Rd. On the north side of Pflaum Rd west 2000' to Spaanem Ave & Kvamme Ln area to an existing utility pole located on the north side of Pflaum Rd. Work being done for 4417 Helgesen Drive

The fiber cable will be directional bored and placed in the public ROW.

Restoration of any damage within the limits of the road right-of-way will be completed in accordance with the City of Madison's standard specifications. All damaged sidewalk slabs will be replaced with 5" lift concrete. All damage done to grass between sidewalk and curb will be restored with a four inch covering of black dirt and seed. All restoration required within the traveled portion of the roadway will also be completed in accordance with the City of Madison's standard specifications.
